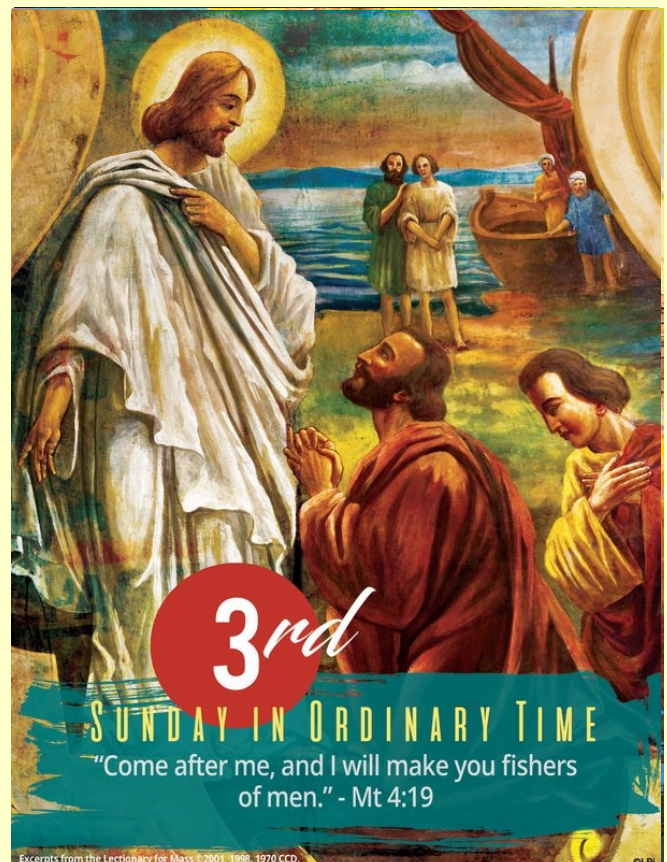

If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or you may register online at [blsac.org](http://blsac.org).

**BAPTISM:** Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory class is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

**MARRIAGE:** Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a wedding.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION:** Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please email [blsacfaithformation@gmail.com](mailto:blsacfaithformation@gmail.com).

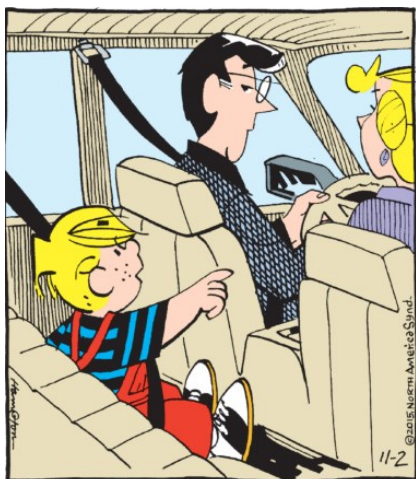

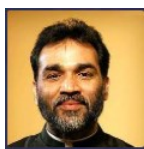

# SAINT OF THE WEEK

## St. Thomas Aquinas

Thomas was the youngest of four brothers born in the influential family of Roccasecca, near Aquino, in the then Kingdom of Sicily. His mother, Theodora Galluccio, Countess of Teano, was a member of the Rossi branch of the Neapolitan Caracciolo family. His paternal uncle, Sinibald, was abbot of Monte Cassino, the oldest Benedictine monastery. At the age of five, Thomas began his early education at Monte Cassino. While the rest of the family's sons pursued military careers, the family intended for Thomas to follow his uncle into the abbacy; this would have been a normal career path for a younger son of Southern Italian nobility.

However, owing to political reasons, he was enrolled at the studium generale (university) established by Frederick in Naples. It was at this university that Thomas was presumably introduced to Aristotle, Averroes, and Maimonides, all of whom would influence his theological philosophy. During his studies in Naples, Thomas also came under the influence of John of St. Julian, a Dominican preacher there, who was part of the Dominican Order's active effort to recruit devout followers. Thomas decided to join the Dominican order when he was 19. It was against his family's will. Thomas was held prisoner for almost one year in the family castles at Monte San Giovanni and Roccasecca in an attempt to prevent him from assuming the Dominican habit. At one point, two of his brothers resorted to hiring a prostitute to seduce him, presumably because sexual temptation might dissuade him from a life of celibacy. Of course, their attempts were futile.

By 1244, seeing that all her attempts to dissuade Thomas had failed, Theodora sought to save the family's dignity, arranging for Thomas to escape. The Dominicans sent Thomas first to Naples and then to Rome to meet Johannes von Wildeshausen, the Master General of the Dominican Order.

Thomas started studying at the Faculty of the Arts at the University of Paris, where he most likely met Dominican scholar Albertus Magnus, then the holder of the Chair of Theology at the College of St. James in Paris. Thereafter, his life was one of divine scholarship. He dedicated his life to study, teaching at different universities, writing books that simplified theology for the masses, preaching, and defending the faith in scholarly discussions and debates.

In 1274, Pope Gregory X summoned Thomas to attend the Second Council of Lyon. The council was to open on 1 May 1274, and it was Gregory's attempt to heal the Great Schism of 1054, which had divided the Catholic Church in the West from the Eastern Orthodox Church. At the meeting, Thomas's work for Pope Urban IV concerning the Greeks, *Contra errores graecorum*, was to be presented. However, on his way to the council, riding on a donkey along the Appian Way, he struck his head on the branch of a fallen tree and became seriously ill again. He was then quickly escorted to Monte Cassino to convalesce. After resting for a while, he set out again but stopped at the Cistercian Fossanova Abbey after again falling ill. The monks nursed him for several days, and as he received his last rites, he prayed: "I have written and taught much about this very holy Body, and about the other sacraments in the faith of Christ, and about the Holy Roman Church, to whose correction I expose and submit everything I have written." Thomas died on 7 March 1274 while giving commentary on the Song of Songs.

Although he was only actively writing for about two decades, Thomas managed to write over 8 million words. Thomas's systematic works, particularly the *Summa Theologiae*, are his best-known, but collections of his complete works run to dozens of volumes. His works can be grouped into six categories:

Works written in direct connection to his teaching, including seven systematic disputations and twelve quodlibetal collections.

Philosophical commentaries – eleven on Aristotle, and two each on Boethius and Proclus.

Lesser tracts, including polemic writings, letters, expert opinions, homilies, and his "catena aurea" collection of glosses on the Gospels.

His systematic works: the *Summa Theologiae*, *Summa contra Gentiles*, and his commentary on Peter Lombard's *Sentences*.

His biblical commentaries.

His liturgical works.

The Catholic Church honors Thomas Aquinas as a saint and regards him as the model teacher for those studying for the priesthood. In modern times, under papal directives, the study of his works was long used as a core of the required program of study for those seeking ordination as priests or deacons, as well as for those in religious formation and for other students of the sacred disciplines (philosophy, Catholic theology, church history, liturgy, and canon law).

Pope Pius V proclaimed St. Thomas Aquinas a Doctor of the Church on 15 April 1567 with the Papal bull *Mirabilis Deus*, and ranked his feast with those of the four great Latin fathers: Ambrose, Augustine of Hippo, Jerome, and Pope Gregory I.

#### **Meditación del Evangelio - 3º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario**

En Jesús se cumplen todas las promesas de Dios. Las palabras de Isaías en la primera lectura nos lo dicen: "El pueblo que habitaba en las tinieblas vio surgir una luz brillante". El gozo se multiplicó y la alegría aumentó. La razón de la alegría del pueblo es sencilla: se rompió el yugo que los oprimía. Experimentar la libertad es algo maravilloso, y se puede gozar de muchas formas: desde una enfermedad, a quedar sano; de estar encarcelado, y ser puesto en libertad; de relaciones no buenas, a romper con ellas. En fin, existen muchos ejemplos. Pero hay uno que debemos seguir muy de cerca: "La gente que vivía en la oscuridad ha visto una luz muy grande; una luz que ha brillado para los que viven en lugares de sombras de muerte" (Mateo 4:16).

¿En nuestra vida, cuáles son los lugares de sombra y de muerte? ¿Dónde debe entrar la luz que ilumine nuestra existencia? La conversión del corazón debe ser la guía que oriente el timón de nuestra vida. San Pablo nos indica una de tantas direcciones: que no haya divisiones entre nosotros, sino, por el contrario, que exista concordia entre las familias y la comunidad. Claramente nos recuerda que pertenecemos a Cristo. La clave está en saber vivir de acuerdo con el Evangelio. El Papa León XIV nos ofrece pautas seguras para llegar a Cristo: "Ayúdense los unos a los otros a construir puentes con el diálogo, con el encuentro, uniéndonos todos para ser un solo pueblo, siempre en paz". "La humanidad necesita de Él como puente para ser alcanzada por Dios, por su amor"

#### Celebración de Sacramentos

**Bautismo.** Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe y los adultos a través del programa de Orden de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos. Interesados contactar la oficina parroquial.

**Matrimonio.** Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos. Si ha estado casado anteriormente, le sugerimos iniciar más de un año antes si no ha obtenido una declaración de nulidad.

**Visita a los Enfermos.** Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

**Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación.** La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa Orden de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos. Interesados contactar la oficina parroquial.

*Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de Miembro Activo. No podemos emitir tal declaración si usted no es un miembro inscrito y activo de Blessed Sacrament. (Ver "Definición de Miembro Activo").*

### DEFINICIÓN DE MIEMBRO ACTIVO

Una familia o un individuo son considerados "miembros inscritos y activos" cuando:

1. Han estado inscritos formalmente en la parroquia por, al menos, tres meses.
2. Participan en el culto mediante la asistencia semanal a las Misas dominicales.
3. Colocan los sobres semanalmente en la cesta de la colecta en la Misa, aunque estén vacíos.

**Un tiempo prolongado sin actividad y sin notificación, colocará a la familia en un estado inactivo.**

- Si usted da su ofrenda en línea, por favor, en la Misa, entregue su sobre vacío. Asegúrese de haber marcado la casilla «I give online», previamente.
- Si usted contribuye ocasionalmente por medio de la colecta de la Misa, por favor, recuerde entregar su sobre semanalmente, aunque sea vacío, y marque la casilla «I attended Mass» que indica que asistió a Misa.
- Las contribuciones en efectivo se registran únicamente si se entregan en un sobre debidamente identificado.
- Si coloca varios sobres en una Misa, estos se consideran como participación en esa única Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.
- Los sobres enviados a la oficina no se consideran como participación en la Misa.
- En la iglesia hay sobres de borde verde disponibles para su uso, en caso de ser necesario. Estos tienen un borde verde.
