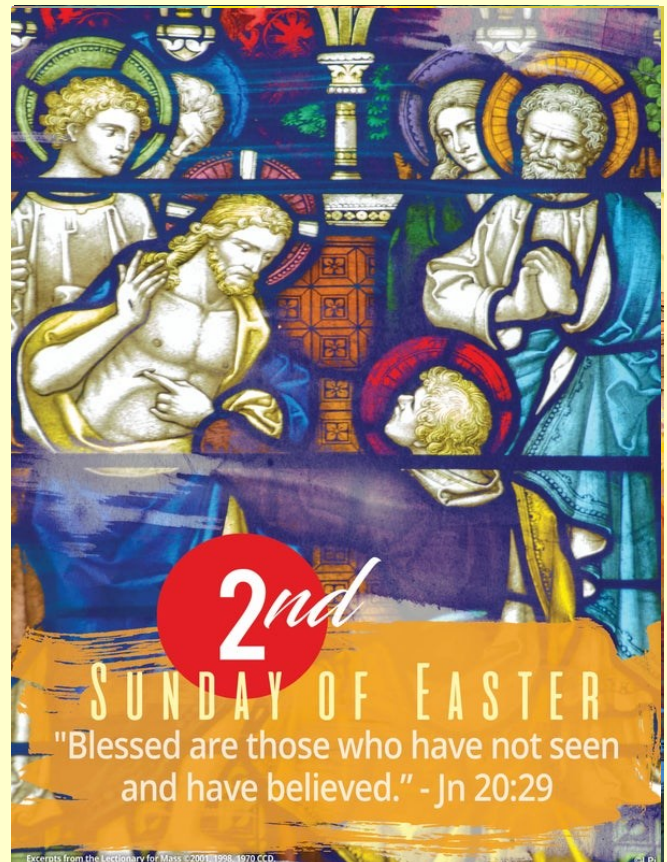

WE WELCOME ALL NEWCOMERS AND VISITORS TO BLESSED SACRAMENT CATHOLIC CHURCH.

If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or you may register online at blsac.org.

ACTIVE STATUS: Families must be active and maintain active status to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School. Active status must be maintained for families in the schools and in any sacramental program.

BAPTISM: Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory class is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

MARRIAGE: Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a wedding.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION: Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please email blsacfaithformation@gmail.com.

VISITING THE SICK: Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will administer the Sacrament.

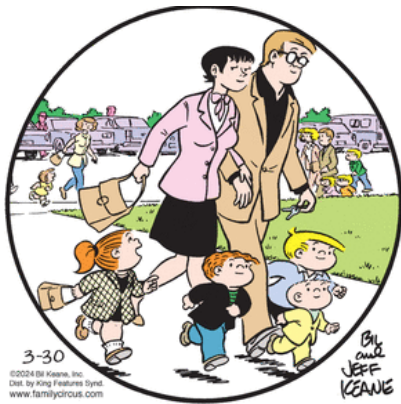

What is EDGE?

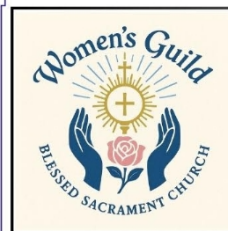

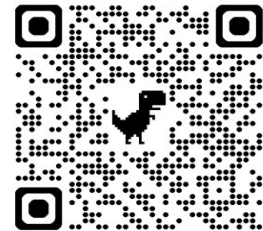

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This month, we live the Paschal Triduum, the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. As we seek to deepen our relationship with Jesus, I encourage you to partake in this month's activity for *Via Fidelis*: "Ask someone of a different age or background about their experiences growing up Catholic." But it's more than just that. It is asking another person how they have encountered Jesus and how it affected their lives.

We each share a unique view of Christ through our experiences with him — but he is the same Lord. On Palm Sunday, a throng of impassioned followers of Jesus welcomed him joyfully into Jerusalem. They saw a prophet, a wellspring of the knowledge of God and the law, riding on a donkey. When he was presented before that same crowd, jeering and rejecting him, Pontius Pilate looked on the Lord with fear, curiosity and even guilt. So follow Jesus with conviction, not emotion.

The women of Jerusalem, and Veronica who wiped his bloody face, saw Jesus through the eyes of compassion. Like her, we are called to be compassionate to the needs of others. Even Simon of Cyrene looked quickly at the Son of God before his cross was thrust onto his shoulders to bear.

Jesus manifests himself in our lives at different moments. Sometimes we forget that we are not the center of the universe. We focus inwardly so often, yet the most important moments of our lives can be found outwardly in the smallest, quietest, most mundane daily things, like the smile of a stranger or the kindness of a good deed. And Jesus most clearly shows himself to us in Mass, where that same sacrifice of his crucifixion in the elevated host makes us proclaim, "my Lord and my God" (Jn 20:28).

I invite you to exit your comfort zone and discuss this aspect of the faith with a sibling, a friend, a stranger, a coworker or a grandparent. Thank you for sparking these important conversations. Like mustard seeds, our own understanding can be grown through dialogue with others about the beauty of our faith.

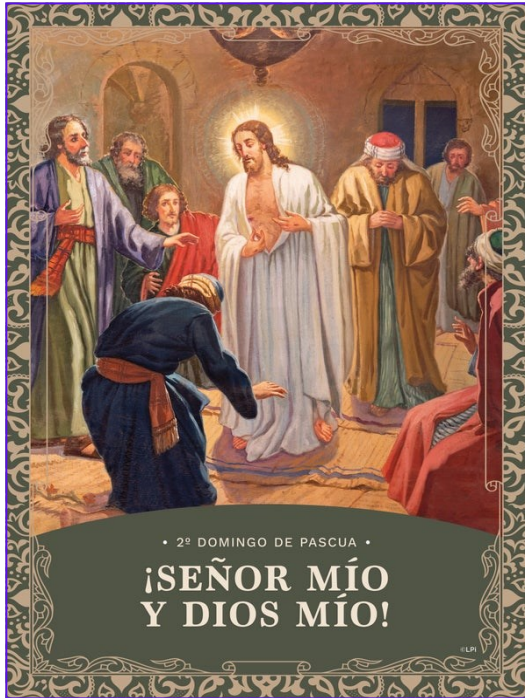

BLESSED SACRAMENT LES DA LA BIENVENIDA A TODAS LAS NUEVAS FAMILIAS Y VISITANTES

¿Le gustaría inscribirse en la Parroquia Católica Blessed Sacrament? El formulario para registrarse en la parroquia se encuentra en la entrada principal de la iglesia, en la oficina parroquial y también en el sitio de internet, blsac.org.

Bautismo. Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe.

Matrimonio. Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial **al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada** de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos.

Visita a los Enfermos. Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación. La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos (RICA), este programa incluye preparación para el Bautismo, de adultos.

Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de Miembro Activo. No podemos emitir tal declaración si usted no es un miembro inscrito y activo de Blessed Sacrament. Para poder verificar su estado activo, debe usar los sobres personalizados que se le suministran, colocándolos en la colecta cada domingo. La declaración de miembro activo de la parroquia se solicita en la oficina parroquial.



Santo Rosario. Acompáñenos todos los primeros sábados del mes en la iglesia, a las 7 p.m., para rezar el Santo Rosario.

Mis Quince Los padres interesados en una Misa para una Quinceañera deben llamar a la oficina parroquial por lo menos 5 meses antes de la fecha estimada para iniciar los arreglos. La quinceañera debe haber recibido la Confirmación.

Meditación del Evangelio - 2^{do} Domingo de Resurrección (Divina Misericordia)

El misterio del Reino de Dios es comunicado por el evangelizador. Ese gran misterio es el que Jesús, en su vida terrena, trató de enseñar a sus discípulos, y ya resucitado, dio continuación a ese misterio. Lo demuestra el Evangelio de hoy: tres veces repite la frase tan necesitada en este tiempo que estamos viviendo: “¡La paz esté con ustedes!” (Juan 20:19). Jesús remarca la importancia de la paz para comunicar su enseñanza. El papa León XIV lo menciona en casi todos sus mensajes: “La paz se construye en el corazón y desde el corazón” y “La paz también requiere practicar la justicia”, por mencionar algunas frases que nos ayudan a reflexionar en su mensaje. Aunque las frases sean cortas, son profundas y nos ayudan a ver al Señor Resucitado, y así poder decir a los más cercanos, como los discípulos dijeron a Tomás: “Hemos visto al Señor” (Juan 20:25).

¿Tú qué haces específicamente para tener paz en tu corazón? ¿Cómo lo demuestras en casa, en el trabajo y en la escuela? Hoy celebramos el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, que está muy relacionado con la paz. Este domingo fue instituido por san Juan Pablo II en el año 2000. Desde entonces, nos recuerda que ninguna persona en el mundo queda excluida de aportar su granito de arena por la paz y de demostrar la misericordia que existe en su corazón, para compartirla con su familia y con la sociedad. La valentía de anunciar la paz nunca termina. Pidamos, pues, con fe, este regalo para el mundo.

Una familia o un individuo son considerados “miembros inscritos y activos” cuando:

1. Han estado inscritos formalmente en la parroquia por, al menos, tres meses.
2. Participan en el culto mediante la asistencia semanal a las Misas dominicales.
3. Colocan los sobres semanalmente en la cesta de la colecta en la Misa, aunque estén vacíos.

Una familia sin actividad por un tiempo prolongado se interpreta como que la familia ha dejado de pertenecer a nuestra parroquia. Si está de vacaciones por un tiempo prolongado, por favor, notifiquenos, de manera que no se asigne estado inactivo; igualmente si es por enfermedad, y así, además, lo incluiremos en nuestras oraciones.

Las familias deben ser miembros activos para poder optar a recibir un sacramento.

- Si usted da su ofrenda en línea, por favor, en la Misa, entregue su sobre vacío. Asegúrese de haber marcado la casilla «I give online», previamente.
- Si usted contribuye ocasionalmente por medio de la colecta de la Misa, por favor, recuerde entregar su sobre semanalmente, aunque sea vacío, y marque la casilla «I attended Mass» que indica que asistió a Misa.
- Las contribuciones en efectivo solo se pueden tomar en cuenta cuando se colocan en la colecta dentro del sobre personalizado de la parroquia.
- Si coloca varios sobres en una Misa, estos se consideran como participación en esa única Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.
- Los sobres enviados a la oficina no se consideran como participación en la Misa.
- En la iglesia hay sobres disponibles para su uso, en caso de ser necesario. Estos tienen un borde verde.

Asimismo, las familias deben ser feligreses activos para recibir un descuento en el costo educacional tanto del Colegio Católico Blessed Sacrament como de la secundaria Bishop England.

Las familias con estudiantes en la Formación en la Fe y los colegios mencionados deben mantener su estado de miembro activo, permanentemente.

**II Domingo de Pascua
de la
Divina Misericordia**

¿Cuándo debe rezarse la Divina Misericordia?

Así como la imagen sirve para recordar el “océano de Misericordia divina” y su precio, así también la memoria diaria de la Divina Misericordia a la hora de la muerte de Cristo.

Jesús pidió a Santa Faustina, y a todos nosotros a través de ella, que celebremos la Hora de la Gran Misericordia, con la promesa de gracias inmensas para quienes lo hagan pidiendo por ellos mismos o por otras personas.

A las tres, ruega por Mi misericordia, en especial para los pecadores y aunque solo sea por un brevísimo momento, sumérgete en Mi Pasión, especialmente en Mi abandono en el momento de Mi agonía. Esta es la hora de la gran misericordia... En esta hora nada le será negado al alma que lo pida por los méritos de Mi Pasión. (Diario, 1320)

¿Cómo se reza la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia?

Con las cuentas del Rosario mariano: se comienza con la señal de la Cruz sobre el crucifijo. Luego, en las tres cuentas, se reza un **Padrenuestro, el Avemaría y el Credo de los Apóstoles.**

En las decenas, se reza lo siguiente: En cuenta separada (donde se reza el Padrenuestro): **Padre eterno, te ofrezco el Cuerpo, la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de tu amadísimo Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, como propiciación de nuestros pecados y los del mundo entero.**

Sobre cada una de las diez cuentas (donde se rezan los Avemarías): **Por tu dolorosa Pasión, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero.**

Se repiten los pasos 2 y 3 hasta terminar las cinco decenas.

Para terminar, se reza tres veces: **Santo Dios, Santo Fuerte, Santo Inmortal, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero.**

Existen otras oraciones que también pueden rezarse a las tres en punto, y que se encuentran en libros devocionales sobre la Divina Misericordia
