If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or you may register online at [blsac.org](http://blsac.org).

**ACTIVE STATUS:** Families must be active and maintain active status to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School. Active status must be maintained for families in the schools and in any sacramental program.

**BAPTISM:** Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory class is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

**MARRIAGE:** Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a wedding.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION:** Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please email [blsacfaithformation@gmail.com](mailto:blsacfaithformation@gmail.com).

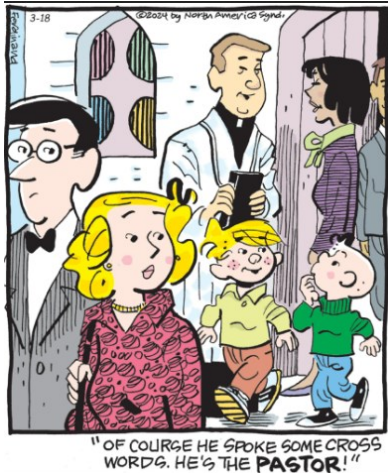

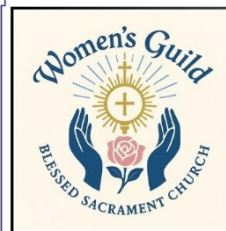

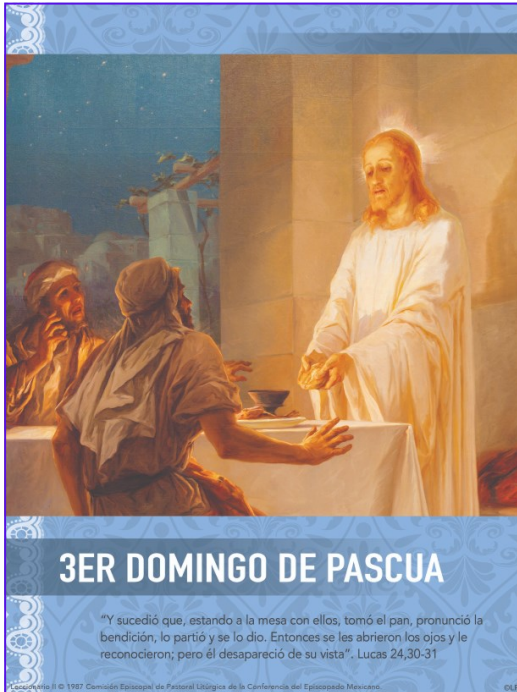

### **BLESSED SACRAMENT LES DA LA BIENVENIDA A TODAS LAS NUEVAS FAMILIAS Y VISITANTES**

¿Le gustaría inscribirse en la Parroquia Católica Blessed Sacrament? El formulario para registrarse en la parroquia se encuentra en la entrada principal de la iglesia, en la oficina parroquial y también en el sitio de internet, [blsac.org](http://blsac.org).

**Bautismo.** Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe.

**Matrimonio.** Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial **al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada** de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos.

**Visita a los Enfermos.** Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

**Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación.** La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos (RICA), este programa incluye preparación para el Bautismo, de adultos.

*Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de Miembro Activo. No podemos emitir tal declaración si usted no es un miembro inscrito y activo de Blessed Sacrament. Para poder verificar su estado activo, debe usar los sobres personalizados que se le suministran, colocándolos en la colecta cada domingo. La declaración de miembro activo de la parroquia se solicita en la oficina parroquial.*



**Santo Rosario.** Acompañemos todos los primeros sábados del mes en la iglesia, a las 7 p.m., para rezar el Santo Rosario.

**Mis Quince** Los padres interesados en una Misa para una Quinceañera deben llamar a la oficina parroquial por lo menos 5 meses antes de la fecha estimada para iniciar los arreglos. La quinceañera debe haber recibido la Confirmación.

## Meditación del Evangelio - Tercer Domingo de Pascua

Señor Jesús, haz que comprendamos las Escrituras y enciende nuestro corazón mientras las escuchamos cada domingo en la Eucaristía. Es tu Palabra viva y eficaz la que enciende nuestro corazón, como a los discípulos de Emaús. ¡Qué alegría tan grande tener a Jesús Eucaristía entre nosotros como alimento vivo para el camino! Jesús se acerca discretamente en nuestra vida de cada día; se une a nosotros, nos consuela y nos anima a seguir adelante. No les dijiste al principio quién eras, sino que les explicaste las Escrituras para que ellos mismos te reconocieran. Aunque fue tarde, lo hicieron: te invitaron a su casa, y allí surgió el milagro de reconocerte.

¿Dónde reconoces tú a Jesús en tu vida? ¿En qué etapa de tu historia se ha unido a ti? Ayúdanos, Jesús, a sentir tu presencia en nuestra vida; que no pases desapercibido, a pesar del ruido y la monotonía del día a día. “Quédate con nosotros, ya está cayendo la tarde y se termina el día. Entró, pues, para quedarse con ellos” (Lucas 24:29). Así de importante es el camino de Emaús, que escuchamos cada tercer Domingo de Pascua. Jesús explica las Escrituras por el camino, no en una sinagoga; se le invita a quedarse en casa porque el día se acaba, y lo más hermoso: parte el pan para todos nosotros. No hay mejor manera de continuar celebrando la Pascua que invitar a Jesús Resucitado a casa, para platicar con Él, contarle lo que nos pasa, las alegrías y las tristezas, por medio de la oración. Para que Él renueve nuestra esperanza y nuestra fe. ¡Feliz Pascua! ©LPi

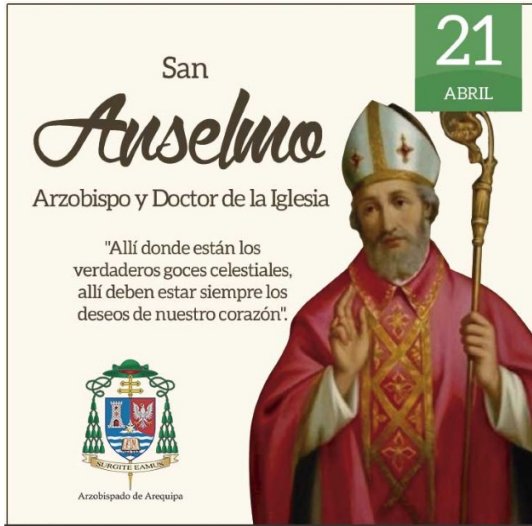
**Las familias deben ser miembros activos para poder optar a recibir un sacramento.**

- Si usted da su ofrenda en línea, por favor, en la Misa, entregue su sobre vacío. Asegúrese de haber marcado la casilla «I give online», previamente.
- Si usted contribuye ocasionalmente por medio de la colecta de la Misa, por favor, recuerde entregar su sobre semanalmente, aunque sea vacío, y marque la casilla «I attended Mass» que indica que asistió a Misa.
- Las contribuciones en efectivo solo se pueden tomar en cuenta cuando se colocan en la colecta dentro del sobre personalizado de la parroquia.
- Si coloca varios sobres en una Misa, estos se consideran como participación en esa única Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.
- Los sobres enviados a la oficina no se consideran como participación en la Misa.
- En la iglesia hay sobres disponibles para su uso, en caso de ser necesario. Estos tienen un borde verde.

**Asimismo, las familias deben ser feligreses activos para recibir un descuento en el costo educacional tanto del Colegio Católico Blessed Sacrament como de la secundaria Bishop England.**

CUANDO LOS HIJOS DE UNA FAMILIA MIEMBRO DE LA PARROQUIA TERMINAN EL BACHILLERATO Y TIENEN 18 AÑOS O MÁS, DEBEN INSCRIBIRSE INDIVIDUALMENTE COMO MIEMBROS ADULTOS Y LOS ANIMAMOS A QUE PARTICIPEN COMO DISCÍPULOS CORRESPONSABLES DE SU PARROQUIA.



*San Anselmo*, un monje benedictino que vivió durante los siglos XI y XII en Europa, es un doctor de la Iglesia y es recordado como un gran filósofo y teólogo. Él fue el creador del argumento ontológico para la existencia de Dios en su obra Proslogion. En él, San Anselmo escribió: "Dios es eso, el más grande de lo que no se puede concebir". A menudo se lo menciona como el intelecto católico más brillante entre San Agustín en el siglo V y Santo Tomás de Aquino en el siglo XIII.

Anselmo deseaba ingresar al monasterio a una edad temprana, pero su padre no lo aprobó. Finalmente dejó su hogar en Italia en 1057 a la edad de 23 años, y entró en el monasterio benedictino en Bec en Normandía, Francia. La reputación de Anselmo como un intelecto superior, junto con su honestidad y devoción, pronto lo llevaron a ser elegido prior del famoso monasterio de Bec. En 1093, Anselmo fue nombrado arzobispo de Canterbury.


En ese puesto, mantuvo sus votos monásticos y presionó por la reforma. Fue exiliado dos veces porque se negó a aceptar el concepto del control real sobre la iglesia y el estado. Él murió en 1109.
