If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or you may register online at blsac.org.

ACTIVE STATUS: Families must be active and maintain active status to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School. Active status must be maintained for families in the schools and in any sacramental program.

BAPTISM: Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory class is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

MARRIAGE: Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a wedding.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION: Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please email blsacfaithformation@gmail.com.

VISITING THE SICK: Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will administer the Sacrament.

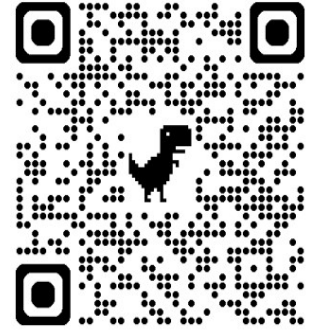

Dear Blessed Sacrament Parish,

Thank you for your support of our two spring fundraisers.

Thanks to your incredible generosity and participation in our 2026 "Monday after the Masters" Blessed Sacrament Catholic School Golf Tournament, we raised \$41,101 toward the Father McCarthy Endowment for Tuition Assistance — bringing our endowment total to \$82,000. We are deeply grateful. Next year, the school and church will together provide \$180,000 in tuition subsidies, supporting 57 students who might otherwise be unable to attend. BLESSED SACRAMENT LES DA LA BIENVENIDA A TODAS LAS NUEVAS FAMILIAS Y VISITANTES

¿Le gustaría inscribirse en la Parroquia Católica Blessed Sacrament? El formulario para registrarse en la parroquia se encuentra en la entrada principal de la iglesia, en la oficina parroquial y también en el sitio de internet, blsac.org.

Bautismo. Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe.

Matrimonio. Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial **al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada** de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos.

Visita a los Enfermos. Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación. La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos (RICA), este programa incluye preparación para el Bautismo, de adultos.

*Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de **Miembro Activo**. No podemos emitir tal declaración si usted no es un miembro inscrito y activo de Blessed Sacrament. Para poder verificar su estado activo, debe usar los sobres personalizados que se le suministran, colocándolos en la colecta cada domingo. La declaración de miembro activo de la parroquia se solicita en la oficina parroquial.*

Gracias por haberte abierto a la gracia, y a la escucha de la Palabra, desde siempre.

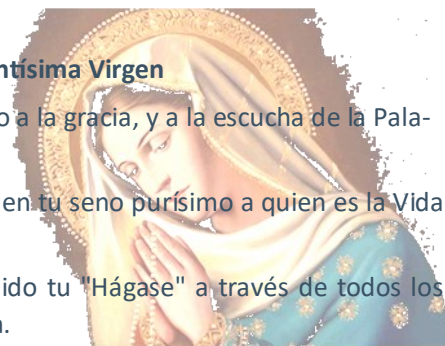

En algunos momentos de nuestras vidas, nuestras madres lo son todo para nosotros, satisfaciendo todas nuestras necesidades.

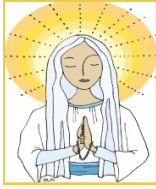
Te pedimos que les proporciones hoy cualquier regalo que necesiten.

Meditación del Evangelio - Quinto Domingo de Pascua. Juan 14, 1-12

Las palabras de Jesús en la liturgia de hoy son como un testamento que se cumple con la llegada del Consolador: “Si ustedes me aman, guardarán mis mandamientos, y yo rogaré al Padre y les dará otro Protector que permanecerá siempre con ustedes” (Juan 14:15). ¿Qué nos toca cumplir a nosotros ante la petición de Jesús? Solamente una cosa: cumplir los mandamientos; es decir, vivir según el Evangelio, siendo caritativos y generosos. Aunque nos cueste dejar el egoísmo, la misericordia puede vencer por medio del amor.



“Cuántas personas se han alejado, por ejemplo, de la parroquia o comunidad por el ambiente de habladurías, de celos, de envidias que han encontrado. También para un cristiano, el saber amar no es un dato adquirido una vez para siempre; hay que volver a empezar cada día, hay que ejercitarse para que nuestro amor hacia los hermanos y hermanas que encontramos se vuelva maduro y purificado de aquellos límites o pecados que lo hacen parcial, egoísta, estéril e infiel. Cada día se debe aprender el arte de amar” (Papa Francisco, 21 de mayo de 2017). Más claro que el agua no puede ser: el Espíritu Santo nos acompaña, y la muestra de nuestro amor a Jesús está en practicar los mandamientos. Pidámosle a Jesús que nos ayude con su gracia a ser dóciles a la voz de Dios. La vida es difícil; se presentan muchas cosas cada día, pero por lo menos seamos coherentes en la fe.

Una familia o un individuo son considerados “miembros inscritos y activos” cuando:

1. Han estado inscritos formalmente en la parroquia por, al menos, tres meses.
2. Participan en el culto mediante la asistencia semanal a las Misas dominicales.
3. Colocan los sobres semanalmente en la cesta de la colecta en la Misa, aunque estén vacíos.

Una familia sin actividad por un tiempo prolongado se interpreta como que la familia ha dejado de pertenecer a nuestra parroquia. Si está de vacaciones por un tiempo prolongado, por favor, notifiquenos, de manera que no se asigne estado inactivo; igualmente si es por enfermedad, y así, además, lo incluiremos en nuestras oraciones.

Las familias deben ser miembros activos para poder optar a recibir un sacramento.

- Si usted da su ofrenda en línea, por favor, en la Misa, entregue su sobre vacío. Asegúrese de haber marcado la casilla «I give online», previamente.
- Si usted contribuye ocasionalmente por medio de la colecta de la Misa, por favor, recuerde entregar su sobre semanalmente, aunque sea vacío, y marque la casilla «I attended Mass» que indica que asistió a Misa.
- Las contribuciones en efectivo solo se pueden tomar en cuenta cuando se colocan en la colecta dentro del sobre personalizado de la parroquia.
- Si coloca varios sobres en una Misa, estos se consideran como participación en esa única Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.
- Los sobres enviados a la oficina no se consideran como participación en la Misa.
- En la iglesia hay sobres disponibles para su uso, en caso de ser necesario. Estos tienen un borde verde.

Asimismo, las familias deben ser feligreses activos para recibir un descuento en el costo educacional tanto del Colegio Católico Blessed Sacrament como de la secundaria Bishop England.

Las familias con estudiantes en la Formación en la Fe y los colegios mencionados deben mantener su estado de miembro activo, permanentemente.
