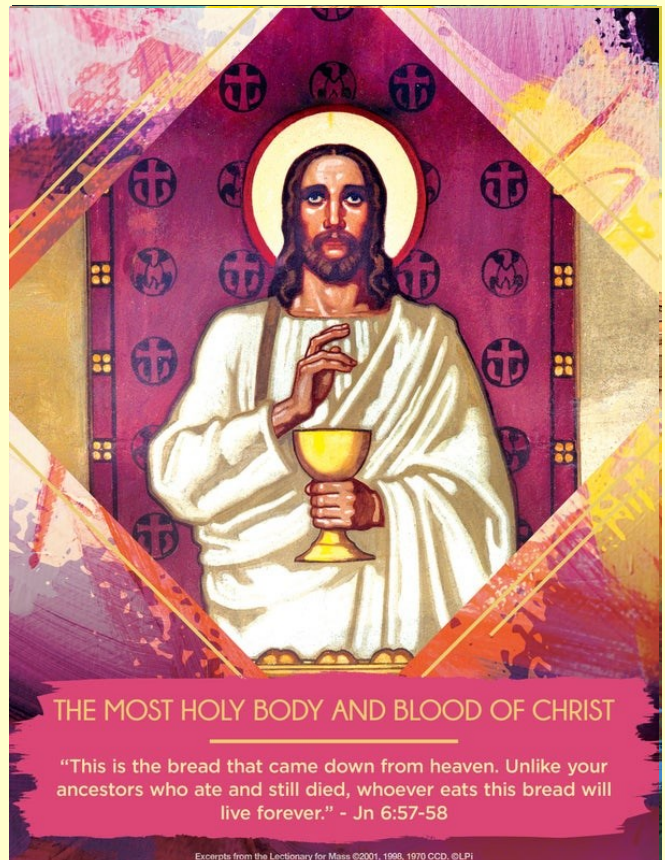

WE WELCOME ALL NEWCOMERS AND VISITORS TO BLESSED SACRAMENT CATHOLIC CHURCH.

If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or you may register online at blsac.org.

ACTIVE STATUS: Families must be active and maintain active status to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School. Active status must be maintained for families in the schools and in any sacramental program.

BAPTISM: Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory class is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

MARRIAGE: Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a wedding.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION: Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please email blsacfaithformation@gmail.com.

VISITING THE SICK: Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will administer the Sacrament.

Parish Life Center Capital Campaign Update

As we enter the summer months, the Capital Campaign Committee is pleased to share the following update. GBA (architects) met with the city and received new information that should allow us to pivot in our planning to accomplish the *same* goals, at a *lower* financial price point. We are moving forward with GBA to the schematic design phase and will be able to share more realistic plans for the revised Parish Life Center soon.

The Building Committee has selected Hill Construction as the pre-construction contractor. They will be working with GBA during the schematic design phase to confirm revised costs which will determine our new and attainable fundraising goal.

Thank you for your continued prayers of support. We are grateful to our Blessed Sacrament family and look forward to updating the parish after this work is completed (August 2026).

*Sacred Heart of Jesus!***

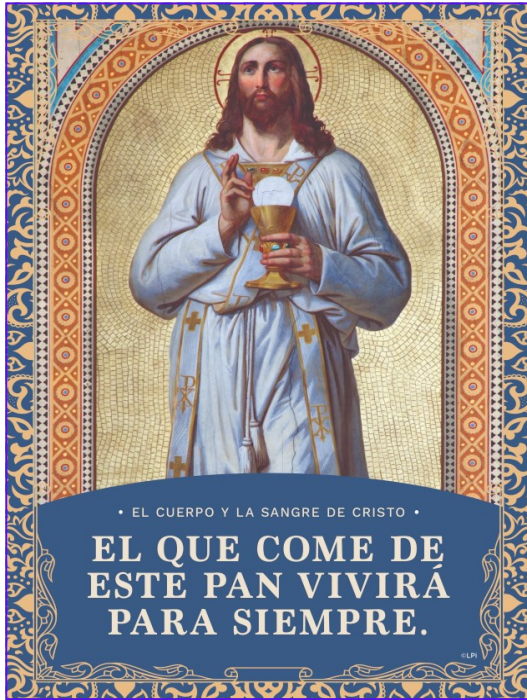
The Enthronement of the Sacred Heart is a ceremony where an image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is placed in a prominent spot in the home, symbolizing the family's commitment to making Jesus the center of their lives. This act involves a consecration prayer and is meant to invite blessings and peace into the household.

THE PROMISES JESUS GAVE TO ST. MARGARET MARY ALACOQUE FOR FAMILIES WHO PRACTICE DEVOTION TO HIS SACRED HEART:

1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their troubles.
4. They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death.
5. I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
10. I will give to priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.

BLESSED SACRAMENT LES DA LA BIENVENIDA A TODAS LAS NUEVAS FAMILIAS Y VISITANTES

¿Le gustaría inscribirse en la Parroquia Católica Blessed Sacrament? El formulario para registrarse en la parroquia se encuentra en la entrada principal de la iglesia, en la oficina parroquial y también en el sitio de internet, blsac.org.

Bautismo. Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe.

Matrimonio. Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial **al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada** de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos.

Visita a los Enfermos. Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación. La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos (RICA), este programa incluye preparación para el Bautismo, de adultos.

Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de Miembro Activo. No podemos emitir tal declaración si usted no es un miembro inscrito y activo de Blessed Sacrament. Para poder verificar su estado activo, debe usar los sobres personalizados que se le suministran, colocándolos en la colecta cada domingo. La declaración de miembro activo de la parroquia se solicita en la oficina parroquial.



¿Qué es la Solemnidad del Sacratísimo Corazón de Jesús?

Esta es una fiesta movable que honra al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. En 1675, Jesús le dijo a Santa Margarita María que quería que la Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón se celebrara el viernes después de la octava del Corpus Christi. En 1856, la Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón se convirtió en fiesta universal. San Juan Pablo II, gran devoto del Sagrado Corazón, dijo: "Esta fiesta nos recuerda el misterio del amor de Dios por el pueblo de todos los tiempos".

En 2026, celebramos la Solemnidad del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús el 12 de junio.

¿Qué es el Sacratísimo Corazón de Jesús?

El Corazón es el símbolo del amor humano. Esta devoción católica honra al Sagrado Corazón de Nuestro Señor, a través del cual se nos manifestó el amor eterno de Dios por todos. "Dios es Amor" (1 Juan 4: 8), por lo que, al honrar la expresión humana de ese Amor, especialmente en la Cruz, honramos Su Fuente Divina.

¿Por qué es importante el Sagrado Corazón?

San Juan Pablo II dijo: "El Sagrado Corazón nos lo ha dado todo: redención, salvación, santificación".

El Sagrado Corazón es el verdadero corazón de Cristo y también indica su amor por la humanidad. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica dice: "La oración de la Iglesia venera y honra el Corazón de Jesús, así como invoca su santísimo nombre. Adora al Verbo encarnado y a su Corazón que, por amor a los hombres, se dejó ser traspasado por nuestros pecados". (CCC 2669)

¿Cuál es la historia de la devoción al Sagrado Corazón?

La base de la devoción al Sagrado Corazón comenzó en el cristianismo primitivo. La Sagrada Escritura, particularmente el Nuevo Testamento, menciona el amor de Dios muchas veces, y los Padres de la Iglesia también discuten el amor de Dios.

En el siglo XI, los cristianos a menudo meditaban sobre las Cinco Llagas de Jesús, y la devoción específica al Sagrado Corazón provenía de esta meditación. Santa Gertrudis la Grande, que tuvo revelaciones privadas sobre el Sagrado Corazón, ayudó a profundizar la comprensión del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús a fines del siglo XIII.

En el siglo XI, los cristianos a menudo meditaban sobre las Cinco Llagas de Jesús, y la devoción específica al Sagrado Corazón provenía de esta meditación. 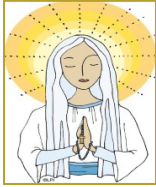
Varios siglos después, en 1670, San Juan Eudes celebró la primera Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón. En 1673, Santa Margarita María Alacoque, una monja de la Visitación francesa, recibió sus propias revelaciones, en las que Jesús explicó Su amor por todas las personas, incluso permitiendo que Santa Margarita recostara su cabeza sobre Su Sagrado Corazón, como también Él le había permitido a Santa Gertrudis. Pidió que los católicos recibieran la Sagrada Comunión los primeros viernes del mes y lo adoraran en la Sagrada Eucaristía.

En 1675, Jesús le dijo a Santa Margarita que quería una fiesta anual en honor a Su Sagrado Corazón. En 1856, el Beato Papa Pío IX designó que la Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón se celebraría universalmente el viernes después de la octava del Corpus Christi cada año.

Meditación del Evangelio - Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo

Gracias, Jesús. Nos das tu Cuerpo y tu Sangre para alimentarnos; nos lo has dado todo, no te has quedado con nada para ti, hasta la última gota de tu sangre: “Pero al llegar a Jesús, vieron que ya estaba muerto, y no le quebraron las piernas, sino que uno de los soldados le abrió el costado con la lanza, y al instante salió sangre y agua” (Juan 19:33-34). Nos diste al Padre, para que sea nuestro Padre; nos enviaste al Espíritu Santo, para que nos guíe en la vida; nos diste a María como Madre al pie de la cruz. Nos lo has dado todo, por eso solo me queda decir: Gracias, Señor, por todo tu amor por nosotros.



¿Cómo responder a tanto amor? ¿Qué debo hacer en particular y en comunidad? Acudamos cada domingo con un corazón agradecido, para dar gracias y alabar al Señor por la Eucaristía. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (número 1324) explica: “La Eucaristía es fuente y cima de toda la vida cristiana. Los demás sacramentos, como también todos los ministerios eclesiales y obras de apostolado, están unidos a la Eucaristía y a ella se ordenan. La sagrada Eucaristía, en efecto, contiene todo bien espiritual de la Iglesia, es decir, Cristo mismo, nuestra Pascua.” Es bueno que, durante la semana, meditemos en las palabras del Evangelio de este domingo. Jesús dijo: “Yo soy el pan vivo, bajado del cielo. Si uno come de este pan, vivirá para siempre... el que come mi Carne y bebe mi Sangre, tiene vida eterna... permanece en mí y yo en él” (Juan 6:51-56; CIC 1406). ¡Sigamos unidos a Cristo por medio de su Cuerpo y de su Sangre!

2. Participan en el culto mediante la asistencia semanal a las Misas dominicales.
3. Colocan los sobres semanalmente en la cesta de la colecta en la Misa, aunque estén vacíos.

Si está de vacaciones por un tiempo prolongado, por favor, notifíquenos, de manera que no se asigne estado inactivo; igualmente si es por enfermedad, y así, además, lo incluiremos en nuestras oraciones.

Las familias deben ser miembros activos para poder optar a recibir un sacramento.

- Si usted da su ofrenda en línea, por favor, en la Misa, entregue su sobre vacío. Asegúrese de haber marcado la casilla «I give online», previamente.
- Si usted contribuye ocasionalmente por medio de la colecta de la Misa, por favor, recuerde entregar su sobre semanalmente, aunque sea vacío, y marque la casilla «I attended Mass» que indica que asistió a Misa.

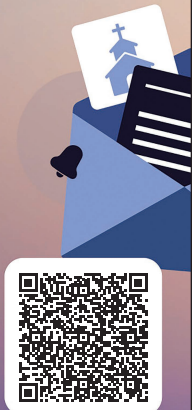
