If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or you may register online at blsac.org.

ACTIVE STATUS: Families must be active and maintain active status to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School. Active status must be maintained for families in the schools and in any sacramental program.

BAPTISM: Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory class is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

MARRIAGE: Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a wedding.

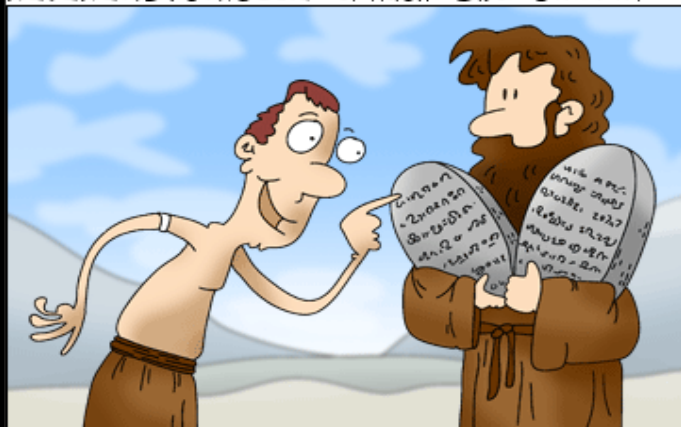

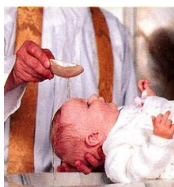

BLESSED SACRAMENT LES DA LA BIENVENIDA A TODAS LAS NUEVAS FAMILIAS Y VISITANTES

¿Le gustaría inscribirse en la Parroquia Católica Blessed Sacrament? El formulario para registrarse en la parroquia se encuentra en la entrada principal de la iglesia, en la oficina parroquial y también en el sitio de internet, blsac.org.

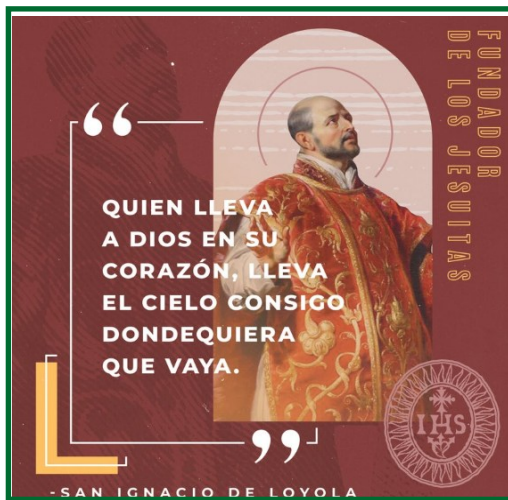
Bautismo. Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe.

Matrimonio. Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial **al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada** de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos.

Visita a los Enfermos. Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación. La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos (RICA), este programa incluye preparación para el Bautismo, de adultos.

Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de Miembro Activo. No podemos emitir tal declaración si usted no es un miembro inscrito y activo de Blessed Sacrament. Para poder verificar su estado activo, debe usar los sobres personalizados que se le suministran, colocándolos en la colecta cada domingo. La declaración de miembro activo de la parroquia se solicita en la oficina parroquial.

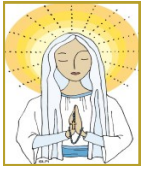

7 DATOS PARA CONOCER A SAN IGNACIO DE LOYOLA

- 1 Nació en el Castillo de Loyola, España, en 1491 y su nombre de pila era Íñigo.
- 2 Dedicó su juventud a la milicia y en una batalla quedó gravemente herido.
- 3 Estando postrado, leyó "La vida de Cristo" y el "Año Cristiano", dos libros que le cambiaron la vida.
- 4 Tardó 15 años en escribir sus "Ejercicios Espirituales", que permanecen vigentes.



- 5 Creó la "Compañía de Jesús" o "Jesuitas", congregación que dirigió hasta su muerte.
- 6 Su lema era "Todo para mayor gloria de Dios".

Meditación del Evangelio - 26 de julio de 2026 **XVII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario - Mateo 13:44-52**

La Exhortación Apostólica Evangelii Gaudium (La alegría del Evangelio), del Santo Padre Francisco, nos habla de la alegría que llena el corazón del cristiano al escuchar la Palabra de Dios y ponerla en práctica. “La alegría del Evangelio llena el corazón y la vida entera de los que se encuentran con Jesús. Quienes se dejan salvar por Él son liberados del pecado, de la tristeza, del vacío interior y del aislamiento. Con Jesucristo siempre nace y renace la alegría” (Evangelii Gaudium, n. 1). Sin embargo, por el otro lado de la moneda, es decir, desde la lógica del mundo, se nos dice que la alegría es algo material, y es tener muchas cosas para alcanzar la felicidad. Pero todo eso es vano y pasajero; la verdadera alegría se encuentra en otro lugar y hay que poner empeño para buscarla.



El Evangelio de hoy nos habla de un tesoro escondido en un campo, de perlas finas y de una red lanzada al mar. Dejar todo lo que se tiene para obtener lo encontrado y luchar por conservarlo es un reto difícil. Esto se obtiene solo cuando se le encuentra sentido a lo encontrado y se reconoce que vale más que todo lo que ya se posee. ¡Qué felices somos cuando descubrimos algo que realmente vale la pena, que da sentido y dirección a nuestra vida! Entonces nos decimos: “Esto sí vale la pena”. Jesús no se cansa de invitarnos a la búsqueda de su Reino: a encontrar el tesoro de su gracia en nuestro corazón, a valorar la perla preciosa de sus sacramentos y a lanzar la red de la paz y la alegría en nuestro entorno familiar y comunitario. ¡Señor, que tu Reino sea nuestra esperanza!

Las familias o individuos que están formalmente inscritos y activos podrán solicitar:

- ◆ Sacramentos de Bautismo, Primera Comunión, Confirmación y Matrimonio
- ◆ Constancia de aptitud para ser padrinos
- ◆ Reducción en la tarifa de colegios (Blessed Sacrament y Bishop England)
- ◆ Preparación sacramental
- ◆ Participación como voluntario en los ministerios de la parroquia

¿Sabe si usted y su familia son considerados miembros activos?

- ◆ Completó el formulario de inscripción en línea o en persona y ha participado de la vida parroquial por lo menos desde hace tres meses consecutivos.
- ◆ Asiste y participa semanalmente de las Misas dominicales (Misa del sábado a las 5 p.m. es Misa dominical)
