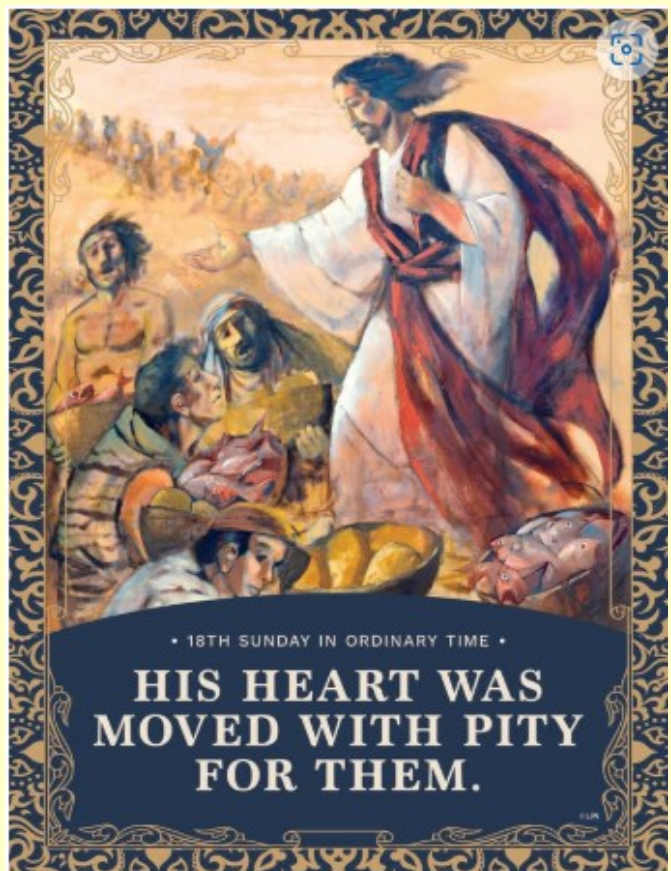

WE WELCOME ALL NEWCOMERS AND VISITORS TO BLESSED SACRAMENT CATHOLIC CHURCH.

If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or you may register online at blsac.org.

ACTIVE STATUS: Families must be active and maintain active status to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School. Active status must be maintained for families in the schools and in any sacramental program.

BAPTISM: Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory class is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

MARRIAGE: Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a wedding.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION: Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please email blsacfaithformation@gmail.com.

VISITING THE SICK: Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will administer the Sacrament.

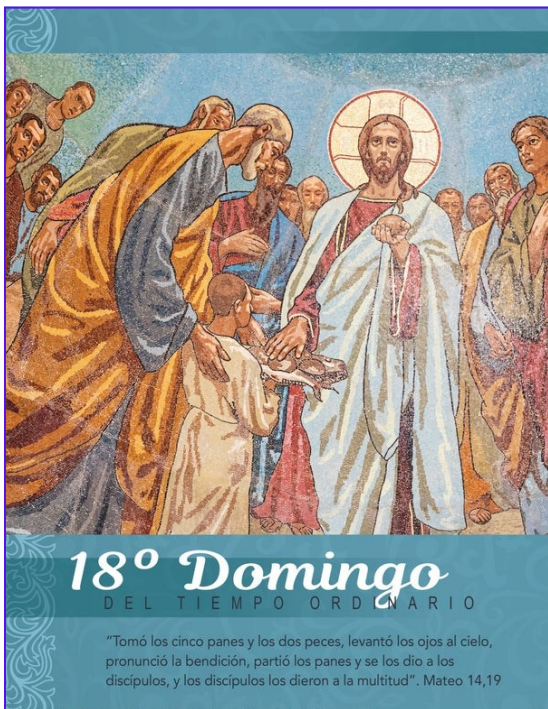

BLESSED SACRAMENT LES DA LA BIENVENIDA A TODAS LAS NUEVAS FAMILIAS Y VISITANTES

¿Le gustaría inscribirse en la Parroquia Católica Blessed Sacrament? El formulario para registrarse en la parroquia se encuentra en la entrada principal de la iglesia, en la oficina parroquial y también en el sitio de internet, blsac.org.

Bautismo. Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe.

Matrimonio. Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial **al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada** de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos.

Visita a los Enfermos. Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación. La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos (RICA), este programa incluye preparación para el Bautismo, de adultos.

*Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. **Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento** deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de **Miembro Activo**. No podemos emitir tal declaración si usted no es un miembro inscrito y activo de Blessed Sacrament. Para poder verificar su estado activo, debe usar los sobres personalizados que se le suministran, colocándolos en la colecta cada domingo. La declaración de miembro activo de la parroquia se solicita en la oficina parroquial.*

Meditación del Evangelio - 2 de agosto de 2026
XVIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario - Mateo 14:13-21

Cuando Jesús se entera de la muerte de Juan el Bautista, decide embarcarse él solo y retirarse lejos. Sintió un profundo dolor por aquella muerte injusta. Sin embargo, el Evangelio nos narra que la gente salió de los pueblos y se fueron a pie por la orilla para esperarlo cuando Él llegara. El texto nos sigue narrando que Jesús sintió misericordia por todas aquellas personas y las acogió, curó y atendió, porque Él no quiere que nadie pase necesidad. Al llegar la tarde, sus discípulos querían que despidiera a la gente para que fueran a buscar alimento. A esto Jesús responde: “No tienen por qué irse; denles ustedes de comer” (Mateo 14:16). A raíz de esta pregunta surge el milagro de la multiplicación de los panes.



“Vivir la comunión con Cristo es algo muy distinto a permanecer pasivos y ajenos a la vida cotidiana; por el contrario, nos introduce cada vez más en la relación con los hombres y mujeres de nuestro tiempo, para ofrecerles un signo concreto de la misericordia y de la atención de Cristo. Mientras nos nutre de Cristo, la Eucaristía que celebramos nos transforma poco a poco también a nosotros en Cuerpo de Cristo y en alimento espiritual para los hermanos. Jesús quiere llegar a todos, para llevar a todos el amor de Dios” (Papa Francisco, 17-08-2016). ¿Qué nos dice Jesús hoy, a ti y a mí? ¿Qué debemos hacer para atender las necesidades de los demás? El reto es confiar en la Palabra de Dios y poner nuestros propios panes y peces al servicio de quien lo necesite. ©LPI

- ◆ Reducción en la tarifa de colegios (Blessed Sacrament y Bishop England)
- ◆ Preparación sacramental
- ◆ Participación como voluntario en los ministerios de la parroquia

¿Sabe si usted y su familia son considerados miembros activos?

- ◆ Completó el formulario de inscripción en línea o en persona y ha participado de la vida parroquial por lo menos desde hace tres meses consecutivos.
- ◆ Asiste y participa semanalmente de las Misas dominicales (Misa del sábado a las 5 p.m. es Misa dominical)
- ◆ Cuando va a Misa, coloca los sobres de ofrenda personalizados en la colecta durante la misa (aunque lo dé vacío).
- ◆ Mantiene su estado activo asegurándose de colocar siempre su sobre con su nombre, aún cuando da su ofrenda en línea.

Observe que:

- Si coloca varios sobres en una Misa, estos se consideran como participación en esa única Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.
- Los sobres enviados a la oficina no se consideran como participación en la Misa.
- En la iglesia hay sobres disponibles para su uso, en caso de que haya olvidado su sobre. Asegúrese de llenar la información solicitada: nombre completo y dirección completa.
