WE WELCOME ALL NEWCOMERS AND VISITORS TO BLESSED SACRAMENT CATHOLIC CHURCH. If you

would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or you may register online at blsac.org.

ACTIVE STATUS: Families must be active and maintain active status to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School. Active status must be maintained for families in the schools and in any sacramental program.

BAPTISM: Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory class is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

MARRIAGE: Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a wedding.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION:

Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please email blsacfaithformation@gmail.com.

VISITING THE SICK: Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will administer the Sacrament.

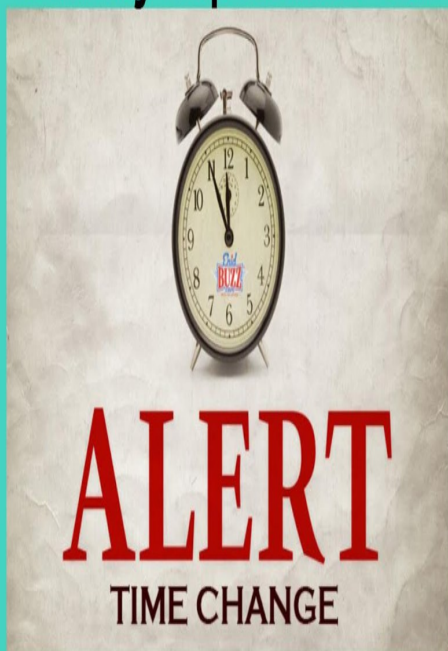

Dear Blessed Sacrament Parish Family,

During my ministry at BSCC, I have come to hear, with increasing frequency, the concerns of our neighbors in Westwood regarding our practice of parking during Mass. Our capital campaign has deepened our lines of communication with those who live alongside us. I have heard their concerns firsthand and taken them to heart. It is time, I believe, that we as Christians examine this matter honestly, and ask what it might mean, in this small but tangible way, to love our neighbor as ourselves — to place the needs of others before our own convenience.

These concerns are not abstract. They include the blocking of driveways, and the parking of vehicles on both sides of streets are too narrow to permit the passage of emergency vehicles. I do not believe there is a single member of this parish who would knowingly wish to delay medical care to a neighbor in need, or to bar someone from safe passage to their own home. And yet, if left unaddressed, this is the effect our current habits may produce.

I am convinced that there exist ways to make fuller use of our own property, and of the surrounding side streets, so that we might lessen our reliance on Moore and St. Teresa for parking. I am equally convinced that many among you possess wisdom and creativity beyond my own, and I welcome your counsel.

If you feel called to lend your gifts to this effort, I invite you to join BSCC Parking Committee. Once a plan has been developed and shared with the parish, we will have need of many hands to help us put it into practice at our weekend Masses. 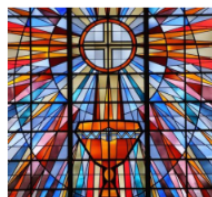

- Preparación sacramental
- Participación como voluntario en los ministerios de la parroquia

¿Sabe si usted y su familia son considerados miembros activos?

- ☐ Completó el formulario de inscripción en línea o en persona y ha participado de la vida parroquial por lo menos desde hace tres meses consecutivos.
- ☐ Asiste y participa semanalmente de las Misas dominicales (Misa del sábado a las 5 p.m. es Misa dominical)
- ☐ Cuando va a Misa, coloca los sobres de ofrenda personalizados en la colecta durante la misa (aunque lo dé vacío).
- ☐ Mantiene su estado activo asegurándose de colocar siempre su sobre con su nombre, aún cuando da su ofrenda en línea.

Observe que:

- Si coloca varios sobres en una Misa, estos se consideran como participación en esa única Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.

Sacramentos

Bautismo

Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe.

Matrimonio

Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos.

Visita a los Enfermos

Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación

Si son menores de edad, la preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe para niños. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa del Orden de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos (OICA), este programa incluye preparación para el Bautismo, de adultos.



Meditación del Evangelio

6 de septiembre de 2026

XXIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario - Mateo 18: 15-20

Hoy la Liturgia nos anima a la corrección fraterna; es decir, nos alienta a corregir a las personas que obran mal. Este consejo parece ir contra la corriente actual de la sociedad, donde se cree que todo está permitido. Los padres tienen miedo de reprender a sus hijos y los maestros temen corregir a sus estudiantes, pues muchas veces responden con agresividad. El capítulo 18 del Evangelio de Mateo nos enseña cómo afrontar situaciones difíciles en la vida familiar y comunitaria. Siempre habrá conflictos; el reto está en cómo los afrontamos. Recordemos que somos responsables de quienes viven con nosotros y que, por derecho, deben ser felices.

Los pasos para corregir, de acuerdo con Jesús, son los siguientes: "Si tu hermano ha pecado, ve y háblale a solas para corregirlo. Si te escucha, habrás ganado a tu hermano". El segundo paso es este: "Si no te escucha, toma contigo a una o dos personas más, de modo que el caso se decida por la palabra de dos o tres testigos. Si se niega a escucharlos, informa a la asamblea" (Mateo 18:15-16). Luego vienen las palabras alentadoras de Jesús, que ayudan a suavizar las situaciones: "Pues donde están dos o tres reunidos en mi Nombre, allí estoy yo, en medio de ellos" (Mateo 18:20). Se necesita saber dialogar entre las personas, escuchar incluso cuando no se está de acuerdo, y tener mucha paciencia para lograr un crecimiento integral de cada persona. Señor, ayúdanos a ser responsables unos de otros y a buscar siempre la justicia y el bien común!
