Bautismo

Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe.

Matrimonio

Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos.

Visita a los Enfermos

Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Si son menores de edad, la preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe para niños. XXV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

“Buenos días, Señor, a ti el primero encuentra la mirada del corazón, apenas nace el día: Tú eres la luz y el sol de mi jornada. Buenos días, Señor, a ti te busco, levanto a ti las manos y el corazón, al despertar la aurora: quiero encontrarte siempre en mis hermanos. Buenos días, Señor resucitado, que traes la alegría al corazón que va por tus caminos ¡vencedor de tu muerte y de la mía! (Liturgia de las Horas). Mientras tengamos vida, debemos ir en la búsqueda de Dios hasta encontrarlo, recordando siempre que sus proyectos no son los nuestros y que sus planes son muy distintos a los nuestros (cf. Isaías 55).

El Evangelio de hoy es una muestra de cómo Dios ama a todos sus hijos e hijas por igual. Él los busca a distintas horas del día para que entren a formar parte de su Reino y, al trabajar en su viña, todos convivan como hermanos. Sin embargo, el relato nos dice que, al momento del pago, los trabajadores de la primera hora se quejaron, pues esperaban recibir más que aquellos contratados al final de la jornada. La enseñanza es clara: Dios es desconcertante, bondadoso y trata a todos por igual. Lo merezcamos o no; su amor no tiene precio ni medida. ¡Gracias Dios por tu bondad! ¿Qué actitudes egoístas debo quitar de mi vida para entender la bondad de Dios? ¿Dónde veo su misericordia en el mundo, a pesar de las adversidades que nos rodean? ¡Vamos todos a trabajar en la viña del Señor, Él nos espera!

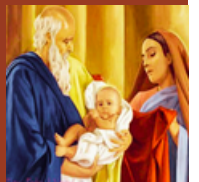

Biografía

Nacido en 1887 en Pietrelcina, Italia, San Pío —mejor conocido como el Padre Pío— fue bautizado con el nombre de

Francesco Forgione y tuvo una niñez marcada por muchas enfermedades, incluyendo tifoidea. A los quince años ingresó en la Orden de los Franciscanos Capuchinos y tomó el nombre de Pius, o “Pío”, en honor del Papa Pío I. Fue ordenado sacerdote en 1910, año en que recibió las marcas de los estigmas, las heridas de Cristo, que eventualmente sanaron. En su juventud, continuó sufriendo enfermedades frecuentes.

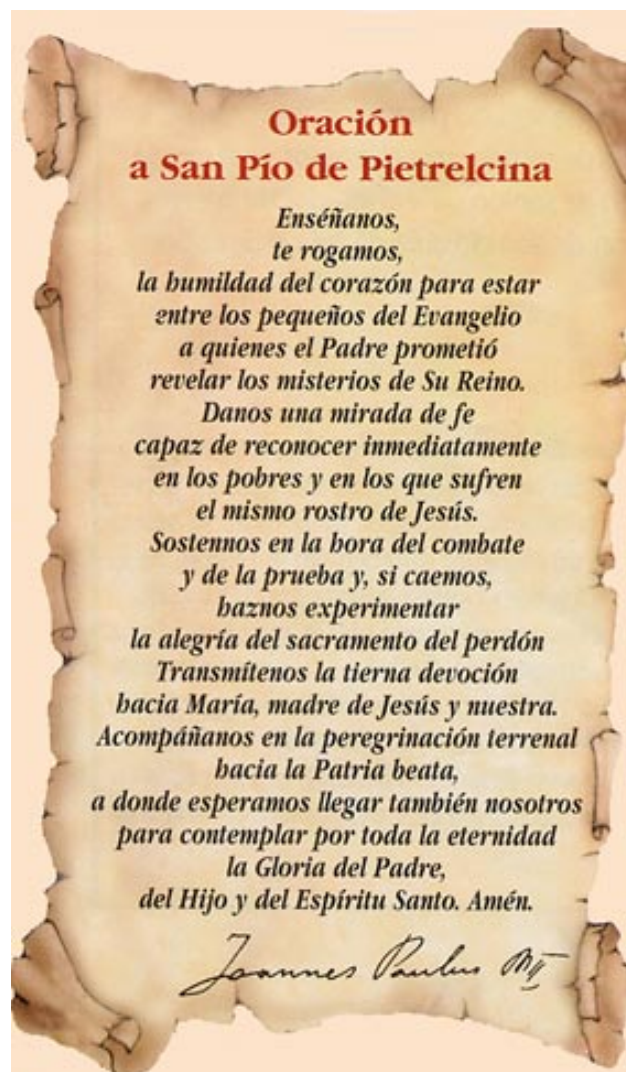
Durante la Primera Guerra Mundial, el Padre Pío sirvió en el Cuerpo Médico del ejército italiano, pero fue dado de baja poco tiempo después por una enfermedad, probablemente tuberculosis. Fue asignado al Convento de San Giovanni Rotondo. En 1918, mientras continuaba sirviendo en el convento, reaparecieron los estigmas y esta vez permanecieron visibles hasta su muerte.

Muchos fieles llegaban a verlo al convento. Sus jornadas eran largas, comenzaba a las 5:00 a.m. con la Santa Misa, luego escuchaba confesiones durante todo el día, con pausas para bendecir a los enfermos. Era un hombre sencillo, contento de hacer la voluntad de Dios en la tierra y con un deseo ardiente de servir a los enfermos y a los pobres, en quienes miraba a Cristo. Impulsó la construcción del hospital Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza (Casa del Alivio del Sufrimiento) en San Giovanni Rotondo, inaugurado en 1956.
