

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration Overview and Instructions

Thank you for committing to one specific hour each week to adore the Real Presence of Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Upon your arrival

1. **Please sign in.**
2. **Ring the bell or tell the person you are relieving that you are there.**

MOST IMPORTANT RULE: Never leave the Chapel unattended. If the next person is late, please remain until they come. If you have something pressing, call or text Patti Brassington 843-901-9467. If she does not respond in a timely fashion call Bob Poyer 843-571-5941 – do not text- it is a landline or if email (poerrk@gmail.com) if an immediate response is not required. A suggestion: please exchange phone numbers with the person scheduled before and after you so that you can communicate with each other in case one is late or cannot make it at the last minute. See **“If something comes up...”** below.

Security:

1. A passcode is required to enter the chapel from the outside of the building from 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM Monday through Friday. Your passcode is the last four numbers of your cell phone number plus # sign. If your cell phone number changes, please communicate this to Patti Brassington or Bob Poyer.
2. Visitors to the Adoration Chapel between 7:00 PM until 7 :00 AM Monday through Friday who do not have passcodes will not be able to get into the Chapel unless you release the door to allow them in.
3. If a person rings the doorbell or knocks on the door and you do not want to let them in, you don't have to. You should be able to see the person through the stained-glass window. There is a motion light over the Adoration Chapel Door for your safety. If the light is not on, push the left light switch near the Holy Water Container.
4. If you are concerned about your safety or someone else's, call 911. The police always have someone patrolling on Savannah Highway. They will be there within in two or three minutes if not sooner. There is a phone near the books on the front right side of the Chapel if needed.

If something comes up and you cannot make your appointed hour:

1. Please try to get someone to replace you. There is a substitute list to the right of the sign-in book. Please take one. Many adorers have a good friend, parishioner or neighbor to turn to in these times of need.
2. Ask the person before or ahead of you if they would do two hours or ask the adorer before you to stay an extra 30 minutes and the adorer after you to come in 30 minutes earlier.
3. If there is an emergency or something comes up at the last-minute call or text Patti Brassington 843-901-9467 and then Bob Poyer 843-571-5941 if she does not respond in a timely manner.

If the Chapel is going to close for any reason, the closure and when it will open reopen will be posted on the Parish Website <https://www.blsac.org> and sent out on the Parish App. Patti Brassington (843-901-9467) will call or text you as soon as she can. Bob Poyer will email you if he has your email address.
