	AD 33	Our current Gregorian Calendar*
The Passover	30 th April	28 th April
Crucifixion	1 st May	29 th April
Resurrection – <i>at midnight</i>	3 rd – 4 th May	1 st – 2 nd May

* Corrections made in 1582 and 1752 from the Julian Calendar were two days out.

'The same day at evening' in John 20:19 shows that God changed the start of the day from 6 pm to midnight from this point.
