Baptism in the Name of Jesus (Christ)

Acts 2:38

³⁸ Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be **baptized in the name of Jesus Christ** for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.”

Acts 8:15-17

^{15b} ... they ... prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. ¹⁶ For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been **baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus**.

¹⁷ Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

Acts 10:46-48

^{46b} Then Peter answered, ⁴⁷ “Can anyone forbid water, that these should not be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?” ^{48a} And he commanded them to be **baptized in the name of the Lord**. Then they asked him to stay a few days.

Acts 19:4-5

⁴ Then Paul said, “John indeed **baptized** with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on **Christ Jesus**.”

⁵ When they heard this, they were **baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus**.

Acts 22:16

¹⁶ And now why are you waiting? Arise and be **baptized**, and wash away your sins, calling **on the name of the Lord**.’

Romans 6:3

³ Or do you not know that as many of us as were **baptized into Christ Jesus** were baptized into His death?

Galatians 3:27

²⁷ For as many of you as were **baptized into Christ** have put on Christ.

The exact wording ...

^{19b} ‘baptizing them in **the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit**’ ...

was **ONLY** used in **Matthew 28:19**, and it was a very precise instruction just to **the JEWS**, recorded by Matthew.

It will be for people saved during the Tribulation and Millennial Kingdom.
