B Spring Feasts

- 1 Passover
 - 2 Unleavened Bread
 - 3 Weeks ('Sabbaths')
starting with **Firstfruits**
 - 4 Pentecost
- } Already fulfilled by Jesus

C Autumnal Feasts

- 5 Trumpets
 - 6 Day of Atonement
 - 7 Tabernacles
- } To be fulfilled by Jesus on His return
- (In the wilderness – in tents and booths)

	AD 33	Our current Gregorian Calendar*
The Passover	30 th April	28 th April
Crucifixion	1 st May	29 th April
Resurrection – at midnight	3 rd – 4 th May	1 st – 2 nd May

**Corrections made in 1582 and 1752 from the Julian Calendar were two days out.*

'The same day at evening' in John 20:19 shows that God changed the start of the day from 6pm to midnight from this point.
