YOUR DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1: NEW YORK/TEL AVIV – We depart on an international overnight flight to Tel Aviv. Dinner and breakfast are served on board.

DAY 2: We arrive in Tel Aviv and are off and running. Our late afternoon arrival allows us to have a beautiful drive up the coast, through the valley of Aijalon, where the sun stood still for Joshua's victory. We see familiar names like Lod, an ancient town in the Sharon Valley where Peter healed a paralytic man. Driving north along the sea, we pass through Caesarea and stop for a gorgeous view over the Mediterranean from the beach where Herod situated the aqueducts to bring water to the city. It is then on to Tiberias and the first night in a our lovely hotel.

DAY 3: Our first morning in the Holy Land begins with an unforgettable sunrise service overlooking the Sea of Galilee. After breakfast, we enjoy a lovely boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and a visit to the Ancient Boat Museum. Next, we drive to the mountain where Christ's Sermon on the Mount is commemorated and then make our way northward toward Caesarea Philippi to dwell on Peter's confession. Along the way, we have a view of Hazor, and we stop briefly at Tel Dan for a view of the Abraham Gate. We then drive south along the Golan Heights for a visit at Jesus' adopted hometown of Capernaum. Our final stops are the ruins of the 1st century synagogue at Magdala and some time at the end of the Jesus Trail at the foot of Mount Arbel. A relaxing and delicious dinner have us ready for a good night's rest.

DAY 4: We wake up refreshed, load our luggage on the bus, and drive to Yardenit, a place for baptism in the Jordan River for those that wish to do so. Then we head west toward Nazareth for a stunning view and orientation on Mount Precipice. We continue across the Jezreel Valley to Gideon's Spring, where God separated His 300 for the victory over the Midianites. After this, we get an unforgettable visit at Tel Megiddo, considering centuries of battles with thoughts of God's ultimate victory in mind. After lunch at a Druze restaurant on the drive toward Mount Carmel, we will be ready for the site where Elijah prayed down fire and slew the prophets of Baal. Our next stop is at the incredible city of Caesarea, an architectural marvel built as Herod's homage to Caesar Tiberius, including the palace, the theatre, and the Hippodrome. At last, we make our ascent toward Jerusalem, making one last stop at the Elah Valley, where David met and mastered Goliath for the cause of the Lord! We reach Jerusalem for a tasty dinner and some rest.

DAY 5: Jerusalem, Bethlehem – We begin this morning atop the Mount of Olives for a glorious view of the classic Old City scene across the Kidron Valley. After getting oriented, we begin our walk down the Palm Sunday Road toward the Garden of Gethsemane. A brief stop at Dominus Flavit gives us a few moments to reflect on Christ's passion for the people of Israel. Proceeding to the bottom of the road, we spend a little while in solemn reflection of our Lord's agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. From here, our bus picks us up again and we make the drive to Bethlehem just a few miles away. Once at Bethlehem, we have time for shopping at a lovely olive wood shop, then a hearty lunch has us prepared to see the sites at Bethlehem, including the Church of the Nativity and the fields of Boaz as well as the Shepherds who came to the manger at Christ's birth. We return to the hotel in Jerusalem for some food and rest, and maybe a little exploration of the Jaffa Market for those feeling adventurous.

DAY 6: Dead Sea Day – We are up and headed east down the "Jericho Road" to the Dead Sea, where we will spend our day. Here at the lowest place on earth, we visit Qumran, site of the initial discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls in the 1940's. We proceed further south for a visit to the lower falls of En Gedi spring where David hid from Saul and spared his life. An unforgettable tour of the Masada fortress has us ready for some time floating in the Dead Sea before making our sunset approach to Jerusalem. Perhaps we will have opportunity for a desert camel ride along the way. Our entrance into Jerusalem brings us by the Mount of Olives and a stunning evening view of the Temple Mount and the Old City before coming at last to our hotel. A tasty dinner, a good shower, and a comfortable bed make a fitting end to an exciting day.

DAY 7: JERUSALEM — Today we participate in a full day tour of the Old City, beginning with a visit to the site of Jesus' trial before Pilate just south of the Jaffa Gate. Our bus takes us promptly to the Garden Tomb for a special service remembering our Lord's death, burial, and resurrection. Following this, we visit Mount Zion, seeing the Upper Room to remember the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Upon entrance of the Old City through the Zion Gate, we tour along the Cardo and come to our lunch stop, where we will also have a little time for shopping. Setting off through the bustling streets once again, we make our way down to the Western Wall for a time of prayer. Leaving the Wall, we come to the Pool of Bethesda and the St. Ann's Church, remembering the Lord's healing of the man in John 5.We exit the Old City through the St. Stephen's Gate in time to make our end of the day appointment at the City of David, the Jerusalem of David's time! It is difficult to keep track of all the amazing finds coming out of the excavations there. It is a fitting end to a fantastic day!

DAY 8: JERUSALEM/PETRA/AMMAN — We check out of the hotel after breakfast and depart early for the Allenby bridge to cross into Jordan for a full day trip to Petra to explore "The Red Rose City". This site is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Petra is more than 2,000 years old and dominated the trade routes. It was completely lost and remained that way for 300 years. In 1812 it was "rediscovered". Petra is carved out of rock deep inside a narrow gorge. We will see the Palace Tomb, the Monastery, and the Treasury to name a few. Then, we continue to capital of Jordan, Amman, for a tasty dinner and overnight.

DAY 9: AMMAN – Today we drive to the city of Jerash known as the Pompeii of the East and the city of a thousand Pillars. We have time to walk around the ancient ruins which include Hadrian's Arch, the Hippodrome, the Forum, and the Temple of Zeus. As we leave Jerash we continue to Mount Nebo where Moses was granted a view of the Promised Land before his death. Our next stop is Madaba, the city famous for its ancient mosaics, before returning to Amman. Upon arrival we devote some leisure time to walking around the city, shop and enjoy the local culture before dinner and overnight in Amman. (B/D)
