# **Diaconal Dan's Deliberation**



Friends,

Advent 3 is Joy Sunday. It is one of my favourites of the year, because we traditionally have the children's pageant as the message. I thoroughly enjoy giving the children the opportunity to share the gospel story with the congregation. We hand the microphone to the kids and let them lead and teach.

At the Centre for Christian Studies, where I did my theological training, we learned through the model of the learning circle. This model follows the wisdom that each person is both a teacher and a student, and that we learn from one another. It is a wonderful model for the church as we gather in study, in prayer, and in worship. We give space for everyone to lead and teach, to share their wisdom. Sometimes new insights emerge; sometimes we find affirmation of what we already believe, but the dialogue is always happening.

For the Pageant, the children are going to lead us in a "what if" story of the shepherds. We will become the audience of the talk show Where Are They Now? and hear what the shepherds were up to after their amazing visit with the Christ Child. Did they go right back to the fields to tend the sheep? Did they rush out to share the news with their friends and family? Did they start families of their own? Are they still travelling and sharing the good news?

Come out Sunday and find out.
