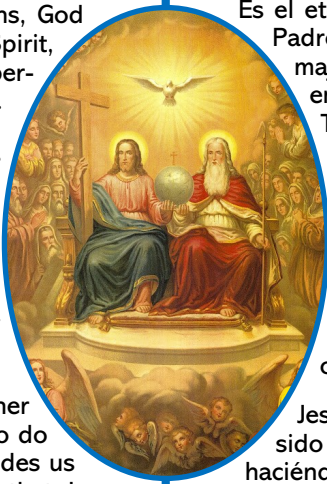
A Christian lives in the realm of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. It is the unique providential world of everyday.
