TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

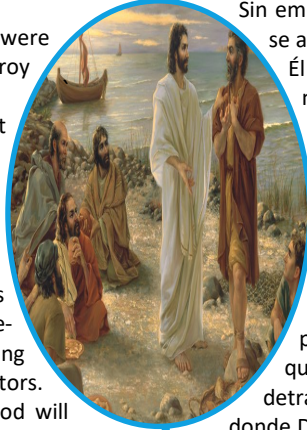
When chosen to serve as a prophet, Jeremiah heard God assure him he had nothing to fear from the people he would confront.

However, no sooner does he embark upon that prophetic calling, he is distressed at the hushed voices of people around him. He is given to know that they plot against him. They were lying in wait for an opportunity to strike him and destroy him.

What is especially hurtful is that those who plot against the Prophet were at one time counted among his friends. They manipulated, turned and twisted, and used Jeremiah own words against him. The prophet Jeremiah was thrown into Jail.

Mysteriously, while in solitary confinement, Jeremiah's outlook shifts from lament to rejoicing. He seems to recall God's promise of protection. He knows he has nothing to fear. God will turn the tables on Jeremiah's detractors. Jeremiah looks forward to that day of Justice when God will deal with the unjust. Jeremiah sings praises to God for delivering him from 'the power of the wicked' working in his head, taking control of his thinking and robbing his peace.

Our First reading leads us into the Gospel. Jesus has just about chosen his twelve apostles. Now he prepares to send them out as missionaries. He cautions them that their message will not always be well received; that they may even suffer and die for it and because of it. But that they must preach with courage and not be afraid of what might happen to them when they meet with rejection.

Jeremías canta alabanzas a Dios para que le entregue el "Poder sobre malvados" que toman su cabeza, tomando el control de sus pensamientos que le han robado su paz.

La primera lectura nos lleva al Evangelio. Jesús había elegido a sus doce apóstoles. Ahora los prepara para enviarlos como misioneros. El les advierte que su mensaje nos siempre será bien recibido; que tal vez ellos sufran y mueran por el y debido a él. Pero que ellos deben predicar con Valentía y no tener miedo de lo que va a pasarles cuando encuentren este rechazo.
