Jesus called out Saint Peter and gave him the charge to be the “rock” upon which the Church would be built, indeed a divine mandate.

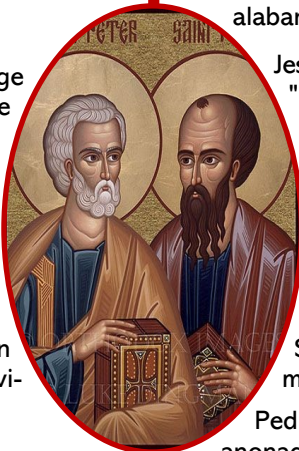
