3. Go out past city lights to do some star watching. How many constellations can you find? Saint Dominic is the patron saint of astronomers and has a feast day of August 8 th . 4. Plan a cookout for your family and friends in honor of Saint Lawrence, patron saint of grill cooks. His feast day is August 10 th .
5. Make a sacrifice this month that benefits another person. Saint Maximillian Kolbe, who gave up his life to save someone else's life, has his feast day on August 14 th .
