Quick Re-Cap

Think about your parents for a second. What do they do for you? Probably things like cook dinner, wash your clothes, and drive you places. Now, think about who your parents ARE. Are they kind, funny, helpful? What are their favorite things? Just like with our parents, it can be really easy to think about what God does FOR us, and forget to pay attention to WHO God is! The Bible says that God is Holy. In fact, it says he is "Holy, Holy, Holy." In Bible times, when words were said three times it meant they were REALLY important. The word Holy means that God is different than anything else in the world, and He is absolutely perfect. He doesn't mess up, and He is BIG!!! When Isaiah met God, all he could see was the bottom of His robe, because God is bigger and better and more perfect than any person can understand. God's perfectness shows us how much we need Him, because nobody in the world is perfect. The cool thing is, God still wants us to be with him! God's perfect holiness should be too good for us to be around, because we all make mistakes. But because God loves us, He cleans us all up if we ask Him to, and makes it to where we can be with Him. That's the best news ever!

Illustration

Back when people first started going to space, there was a mission called Apollo 8. They went further away from Earth than anyone ever had at the time. They had a long check list of stuff they had to do: collect data, take pictures, and do lots of math and science about space. They were so busy working, that they forgot to look out the window! After a time, they finally looked out from being distracted and Bill Anders took this picture. They were amazed. That's what the Earth looks like from space! How cool is that? Sometimes we can get so distracted by all our problems we need God to solve, that we forget to "Look up" and see how amazing He is!



Application
