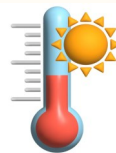


**LOWER MILLS COMMUNITY PANTRY**

ARCHDIOCESE OF BOSTON | CATHOLIC APPEAL

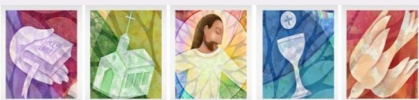
