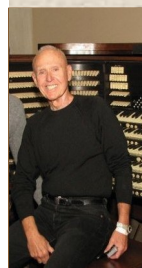
As mentioned before the expected cost to the parish is **\$110,537.00**. As of now we have raised **\$76,282**. To the many who have donated, I am most grateful.
