

For All Young Families Parent Tips Week Four

Tip of the Week: Help children be active participants during Mass by helping them learn their prayers.

Last week we introduced the Liturgy of the Eucharist and the Concluding Rites. This week we will focus on the prayers that we recite together during this part of the Mass.

Some of the most common prayers- the Holy, Holy, the Our Father and the Lamb of God are recited during the Liturgy of the Eucharist. When children are familiar with these prayers and are able to join in, even just for the first line or two as they are learning, they feel more part of the community and the Mass. Take time during the week to pray together and "practice" your Mass prayers. Don't expect young children to memorize all at once, but have them repeat a few lines after you, then model the whole prayer for them. As with all learning, repetition and consistency are key. During the Mass, be sure to encourage them by drawing their attention in ahead of time "Listen closely, the Our Father is coming!" Be sure to praise their efforts even if they just get a few of the words! Let them know you are proud of them and how happy God is when they try!

There are many Catholic Prayer books for children, these are a great way to reinforce prayers at home and prepare children for Mass. Some Catholic resources include The Catholic Company, Pauline Books and Media and Ascension Press among others.
