

PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL (GENERAL INTERCESSIONS)

These two prayers we will pray at each funeral Mass: RESPONSE IS: "LORD, HEAR OUR PRAYER."

1. For (.....), who in baptism was given the pledge of eternal life, may he/she be held securely in God's loving embrace now, and for all eternity, we pray to the Lord...

Category 1: Prayers for the deceased person's loved ones — Please choose one 1A.
