This June, we will finish our sermon series, “The Questions Jesus Asked: That Still Search Our Hearts.” Throughout this series, we have listened to some of the most powerful questions Jesus asked in the Gospels—questions that still speak to our faith, our fears, our priorities, and our relationship with Him today. These questions are not just ancient words from long ago; they are invitations for us to examine our hearts and follow Christ more faithfully.



Then, beginning in July, we will start a new summer sermon series called “Summer Psalms: Prayers for Real Life.” The Book of Psalms has been the prayer book and songbook of God’s people for thousands of years. During this series, we will walk through eight beloved Psalms, including Psalm 1, Psalm 8, Psalm 23, Psalm 27, Psalm 46, Psalm 51, Psalm 100, and Psalm 121. Together, we will discover how these ancient prayers still help us speak honestly to God and trust Him in every season.

Join us this June and throughout the summer as we open God’s Word and allow the questions of Jesus and the prayers of the Psalms to shape our hearts.

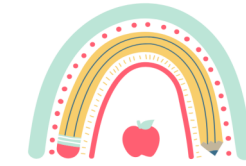
