Council Team Raises \$7,615 in Contributions in Akron Pregnancy Services Walk for Life

Fr. Maruskin Council members and family members participated in the Akron Pregnancy Services (APS) Walk for Life fundraiser on May 16. The Walk, held in the neighborhood near the organization's offices at the Robinson House, 715 E. Buchtel Avenue, Akron, raised a total \$78,000 for the pro-life organization, including \$7,615 collected by our Council participants.

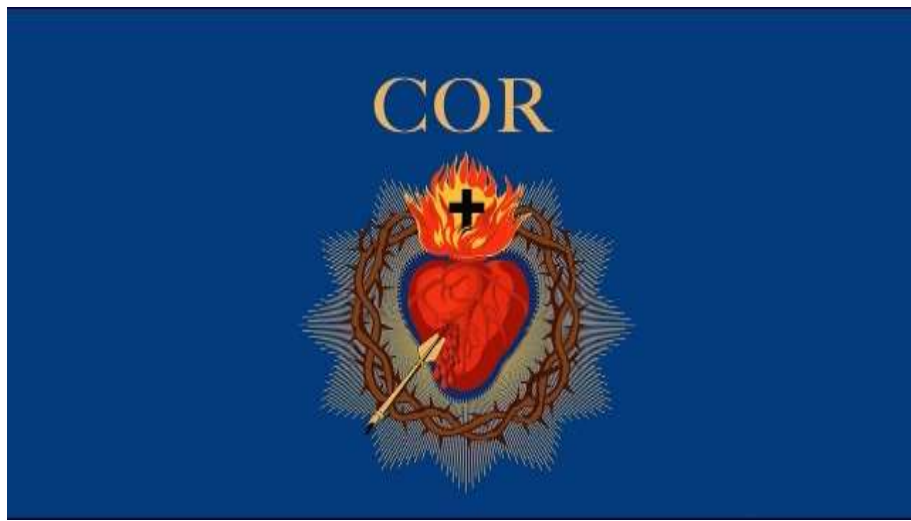
