Holy Family parish staff conducted an evangelization event in conjunction with Stow's Fourth of July parade. Expecting a large turnout to celebrate the 250th anniversary of the United States of America, parish leaders, spearheaded by **Fr. Jon Hawkins** and **Deacon John Green**, recruited Council volunteers to cook and serve hot dogs, chips and bottled water, to help welcome visitors to the parish grounds.

Fifteen Knights manned two hospitality tents, one at the main entrance and the other at the Bell Tower portal. Knights worked the grills, greeted visitors and distributed food and drink.

Knights also directed visitors to the Welcome and Healing Prayer ministries and distributed prayer cards. The Knights served between nine hundred and one thousand hot dogs. Thirty-seven visitors met with the Healing Prayer Ministry and four potential new Council members were identified.
