Three New Schools on Track to Open in July 2026

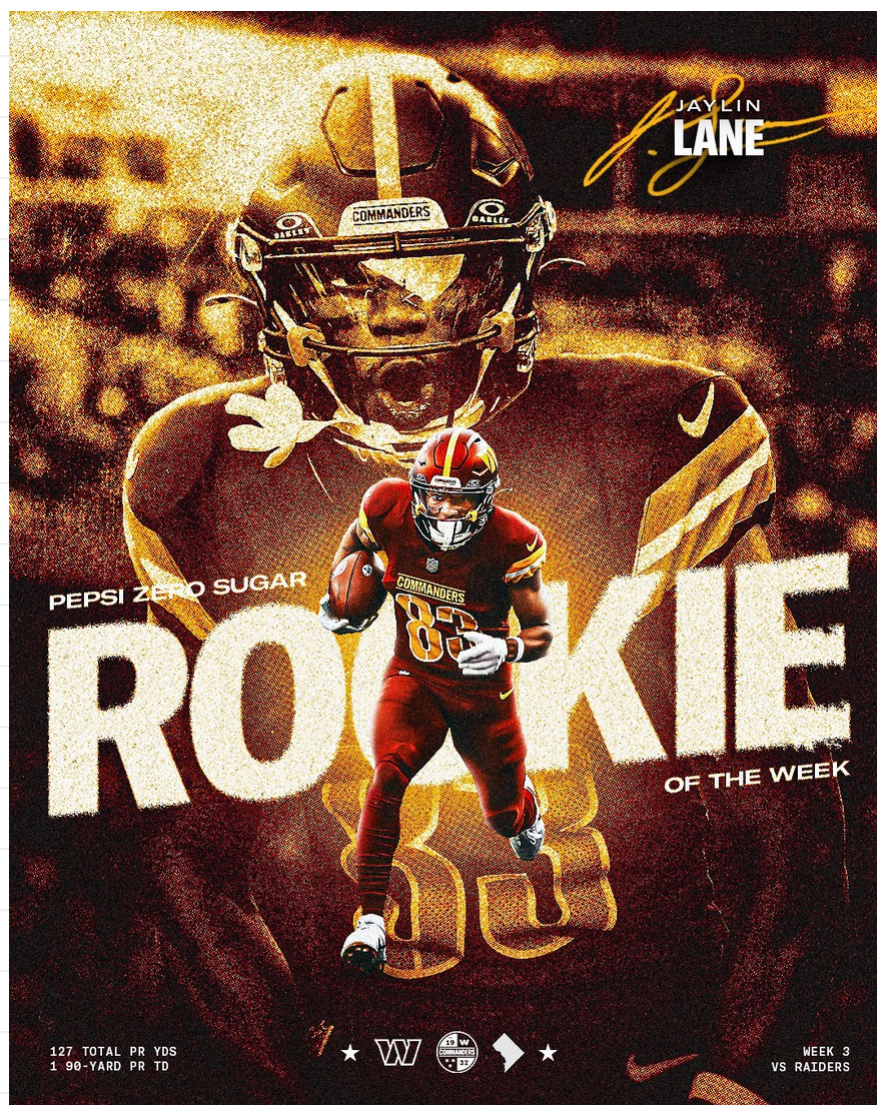
