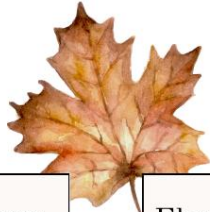
Sherri

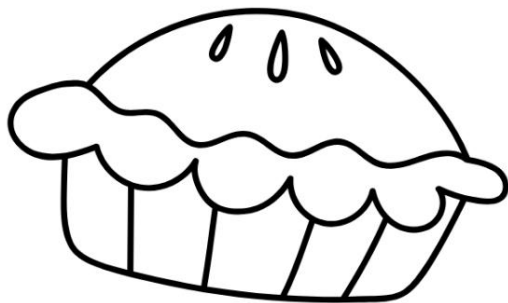
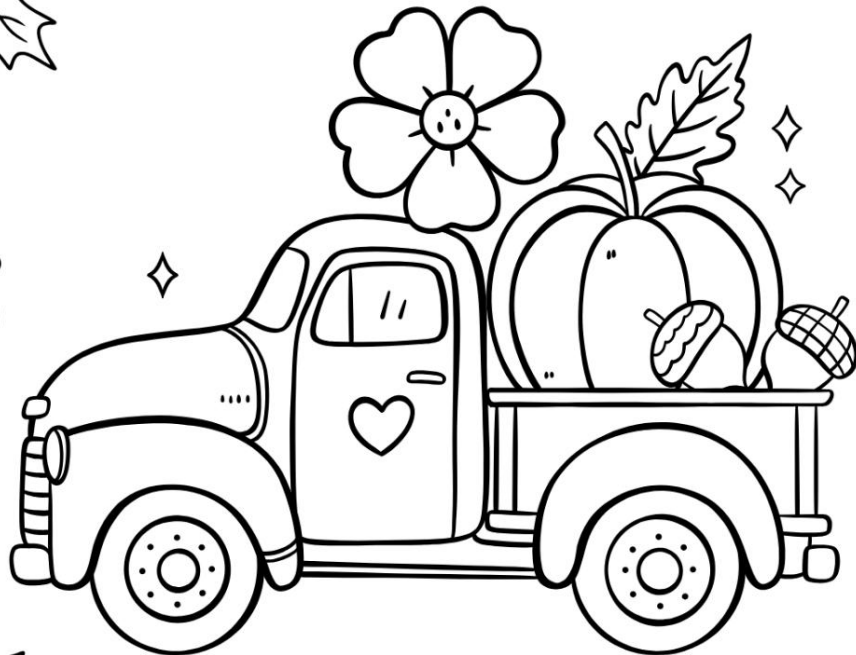
