

TOWN OF EDGERTON
November 3rd, 2025
MINUTES*
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Brow called the regular meeting of the Edgerton Town Council to order at 6:00 pm at the Edgerton Town Hall. In attendance were Council members Ashley Aars, Frank Tucker, Katie Arnold, and Clifford Stewart. Also in attendance were Public Works Director Travis Anderson and Clerk Laura Pierce-Crebs.

Mr. Brow led the Council and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

GUEST: Marvin Crebs, Helena Archuleta, Cliff Stewart Jr., Tara Stewart

CONSENT AGENDA: Member Stewart motioned to accept the Regular and Executive Minutes from October 2nd, 2025. Member Aars seconded. All Ayes.

Member Arnold motioned to accept the YTD Budget, Projected vs. Actual and General Fund Report. Member Stewart seconded. All Ayes.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Mayor Brow asked the council if public comments on the agenda be moved after new business, so the public could hear everything from the meeting before comment. Council Agreed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: None

CLERK/TREASURER REPORT: Clerk Crebs informed the council the amount from Wyoming Community Gas would be \$3156.70. With \$3000 going to the community garden, she asked the council to decide what to do with the remaining amount. Council decided to put the funds towards the gun range.

Clerk Crebs asked for the nomination for the Local Government Liability Pool nominees for a board member. Council decided to vote for Jessica Weaver.

Clerk Crebs said that Blue Cross Blue Shield would be paying Edgerton's January payment.

Clerk Crebs said the vaccination clinic for pets was December 2nd, from 11am-3pm at Midwest Firehall. She wanted to remind council to let residents know that a license tag was still required to get for each pet before January 31st, even with the animal vaccinations being up to date.

Clerk Crebs told council the winter WAM conference was February 11th-13th, and asked who would like to attend with her. Member Arnold and Tucker said they would be attending. Clerk Crebs let council know summer WAM was June 3rd-5th in Laramie.

Clerk Crebs explained the terms for the Website for Edgerton. Member Arnold motioned to accept the terms. Member Stewart seconded. All Ayes.

Clerk Crebs told the council that the Hilltop account was not paying a lot in interest, and asked if they wanted to either switch the account into a CD, or an Investment Management Account. Member Arnold asked to get information on other options before next meeting.

Clerk Crebs let the council know \$392.99 was moved into sewer reserves. None for water reserves due to a lot of unpaid accounts.

MAINTENANCE REPORT: Public Works Director Travis Anderson let the council know he would be fixing the fencing around Town this month.

COUNCIL REPORT: Member Arnold talked about making the Halloween event and every year thing. Member Stewart agreed. Member Stewart said he appreciates Katie putting on the event, and how happy it made the kids.

Member Aars said with being on the Visit Casper Board, she is confused as to why Edgerton is part of that Joint Powers Board. She asked the council to think about whether the Town should remain on the board. Member Tucker said the only advantage may be grant opportunities that may come from Visit Casper. Mayor Brow said the Town received a letter from the lawyer stating Visit Casper was not following the correct steps during meetings. Member Aars said Visit Caspers lawyer came back, and the only thing not being followed was that council was not verifying the expenditures.

MAYOR REPORT: Mayor Brow asked the council to look over the written changes for the ordinance pertaining to weapon use inside Town boarders. He asked the council next meeting to adjust where needed. Member Arnold commented the language needed to be adjusted. Mayor Brow asked the council to also look over the ordinance for hunting within the Town.

Mayor Brow showed the council the ordinance violations handed out for residents. He gave the ones who contacted him and year to fix what was addressed on the violation.

Mayor Brow asked for a vote to accommodate house bill 172, that repeals gun free zones. Member Arnold said she was for it because she carries, but asked the council to consider all parties perspectives, and concerns on allowing this. Member Aars said she carries as well. Member Tucker said the Town could just adopt the law. Member Stewart said we need to be in order with the law. Member Stewart Motioned to allowed concealed weapons to be carried in the Edgerton Town Hall. Member Tucker seconded. All Ayes.
