

You may choose only the items you desire; however, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. You may keep this price list. ### **Professional Services**

#### A. BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF (non-declinable) \$3,295 Our charge includes, but is not limited to staff, facilities, and vehicles to respond to initial requests for service 24 hours every day, consultation with the survivors, coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, and/ or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased, procuring death certificates and permits, consultation and assistance with procuring various death benefits, accounting and billing, regulatory compliance, legal and audit fees, postage, printing and supplies, telephones, insurance, salaries and benefits for our staff, and various county, state and federal taxes and fees. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our packages, direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.) B. USE OF FACILITIES AND STAFF FOR FUNERAL OR MEMORIAL SERVICE \$795 Staff and facilities necessary for conducting services desired OR if facilities are not used the additional time, staff, and equipment necessary for conducting the services off premises. C. USE OF FACILITIES AND STAFF FOR GATHERING/VIEWING/FAMILY TIME \$595 Staff, facilities, and equipment necessary for conducting the above services OR if facilities are not used the additional time, staff, and equipment necessary for conducting the gathering off premises. The charges are for gatherings for a maximum of five (5) hours. Additional charges will be incurred for gatherings of longer duration. Gathering/Viewing/Family Time prior to the service is 1/2 the full charge. \$295 D. USE OF EQUIPMENT AND STAFF FOR COMMITTAL AND/OR INTERMENT SERVICES \$395 Staff and equipment necessary for conducting graveside or mausoleum committal and/or interment services. Funeral services and visitations held at cemetery facilities are off-premise services and not committal services, and because of the additional time required and additional equipment used, they are billed as off-premise funerals. E. OVERTIME/WEEKEND SERVICE FEE \$795 For any service/gathering going past 4:00 pm weekdays and any time Saturday or Sunday. F. PREPARATION AND CARE\* (Embalming or Refrigeration) \$895

**EMBALMING** is a surgical procedure which requires written permission to perform. The purpose of this procedure is to disinfect and sanitize the remains and thus protect the public and staff from complications of decomposition. Embalming provides temporary preservation and allows the survivors to hold services at a time convenient to them. Included in the charge for embalming are all staff charges related to the procedure and the necessary equipment, chemical and facilities, as well as all costs related to the proper disposal of all medical waste, chemical waste and all equipment and materials necessary for compliance with the OSHA and ADA standards relating specifically to the embalming procedure. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

**REFRIGERATION** is <u>required when embalming is not performed</u>. This is a temporary means of holding the remains until disposition occurs. It does not preserve or disinfect the remains for purposes of viewing.

H. TRANSFER OF DECEASED TO FUNERAL HOME	\$795
Includes necessary professional licensed staff and specialized vehicle and equipment for the removal of the deceased from the place of death to the funeral home, 24 hours per day, 365 days per year.

Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering).

Transfer to Funeral Home from airport or other point in the area is \$525 from Milwaukee Airport and \$675 from Chicago Airport. This package presumes no ceremony and no other use of the funeral home and that we may deliver to the cemetery at the time of our choosing. Add to the fee of \$1,895 any additional services selected such as Graveside Service, Other Preparation of the Deceased, Use of Facilities and Staff for Gathering/Viewing/Family Time, and Funeral Service at Chapel or Church.

Immediate burial is the process of arranging for burial of the unembalmed body as soon as possible.

Immediate Burial options presume that we deliver the deceased to the cemetery for burial at the time of our choosing and that there is no viewing or commemorative gathering involved. This package includes Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, Preparation and Care of the Deceased\*, Transfer to Funeral Home from place of death, Other Preparation and Care of the Deceased, Use of Funeral Coach to Local Cemetery.

Necessary authorizations and permits usually take three (3) days to eight (8) days to obtain and file (weekends are sometimes longer) and before any disposition (burial, cremation and/or shipping out of town) can take place, these permits must be in hand. Therefore, immediate burial and direct cremation services will take place only when these papers are obtained, not before.

### Payment Policy

Cress Funeral & Cremation Service is a small business, and like many others in our community, out of necessity we operate on a cash basis, relying upon the families we serve for prompt payment. We do not have sufficient financial resources to extend credit over a period of months or years, nor does law allow us to fulfill the functions of a bank or other lending institution. Therefore, payment is expected at time of arrangements. If payment in full is not completed at time of arrangements, a down payment is required with the balance due in full by the day of the service or cremation.

We encourage your frank discussion of these matters with your funeral director, and we will attempt to assist you in any way possible.

### Payment Options

Payment with cash, check or with an approved debit or credit card.

Pre-paid funeral arrangements with Cress Funeral & Cremation Service, subject to verification the policy is valid.

Assignment of Proceeds of a Verified Life Insurance Policy (additional fees apply).

Cress Funeral & Cremation Service is willing to accept the assignment of proceeds of a verified Life Insurance Policy for a cost of 5% of the amount assigned to Cress Funeral & Cremation Service. Our acceptance of this type of payment is dependent on the cooperation of the beneficiary and the insurance company. The insurance policy must be given to the funeral director for verification. We must have the Insurance Company's complete cooperation in providing information to the beneficiary, amount of the Death Benefit available, outstanding loans information, cooperation to get claim forms in a timely manner, and their acceptance of our written assignment. The insurance company will send the balance of any insurance proceeds directly to the beneficiary after the insurance company pays the funeral bill in full from the proceeds of the insurance policy. The purchaser must obtain a certified death certificate for each insurance policy.
