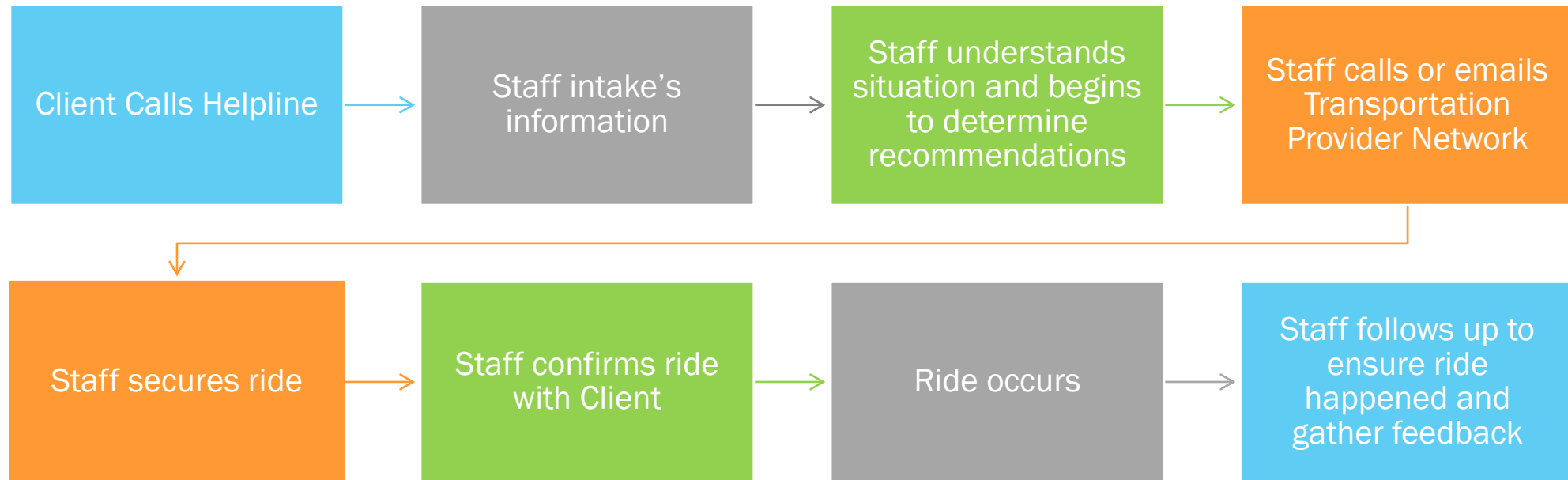

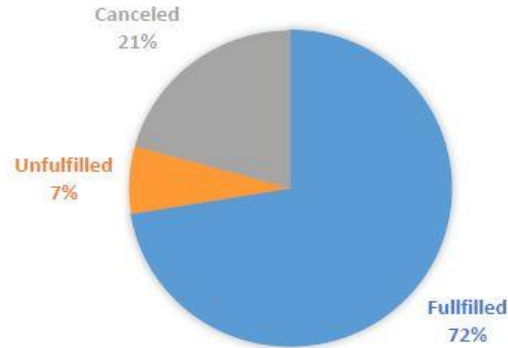

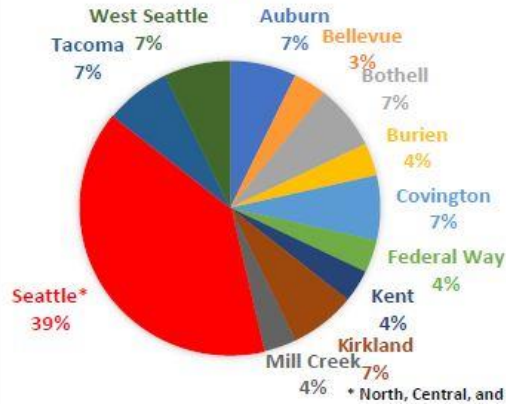

COORDINATED VACCINE TRANSPORTATION HELPLINE DASHBOARD

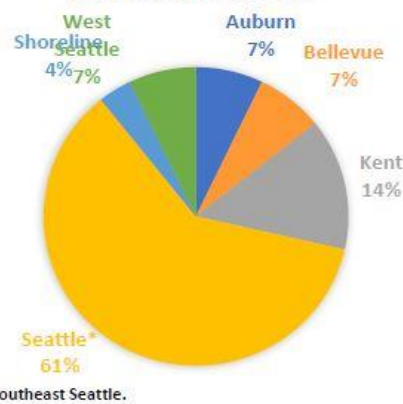

ORIGIN CITY

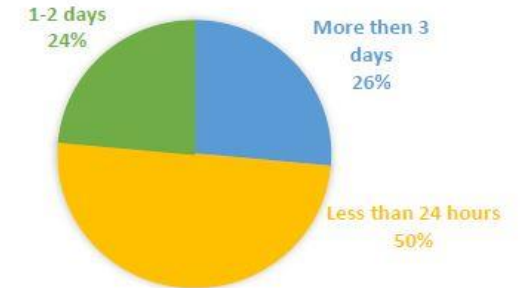


DESTINATION CITY

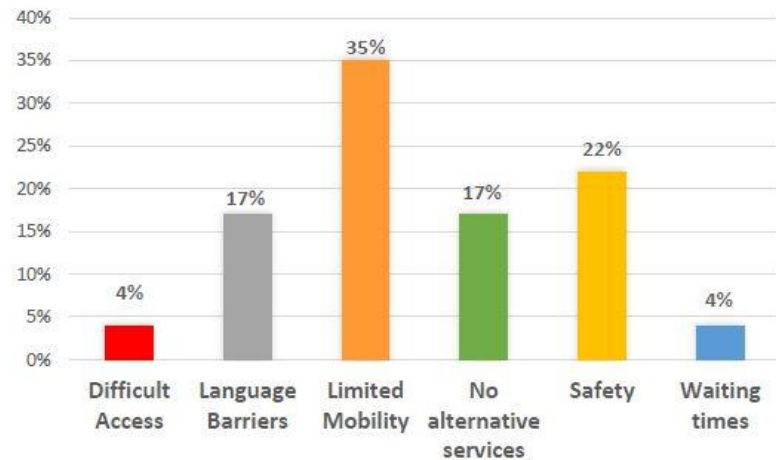

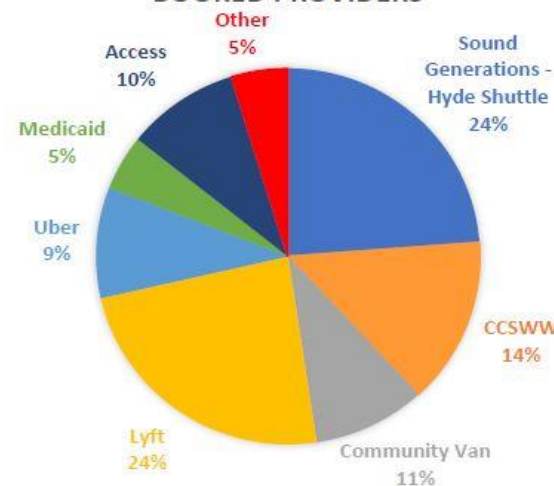

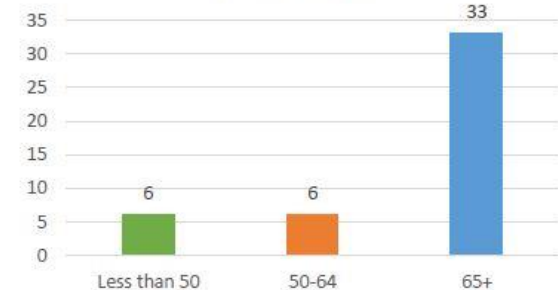
