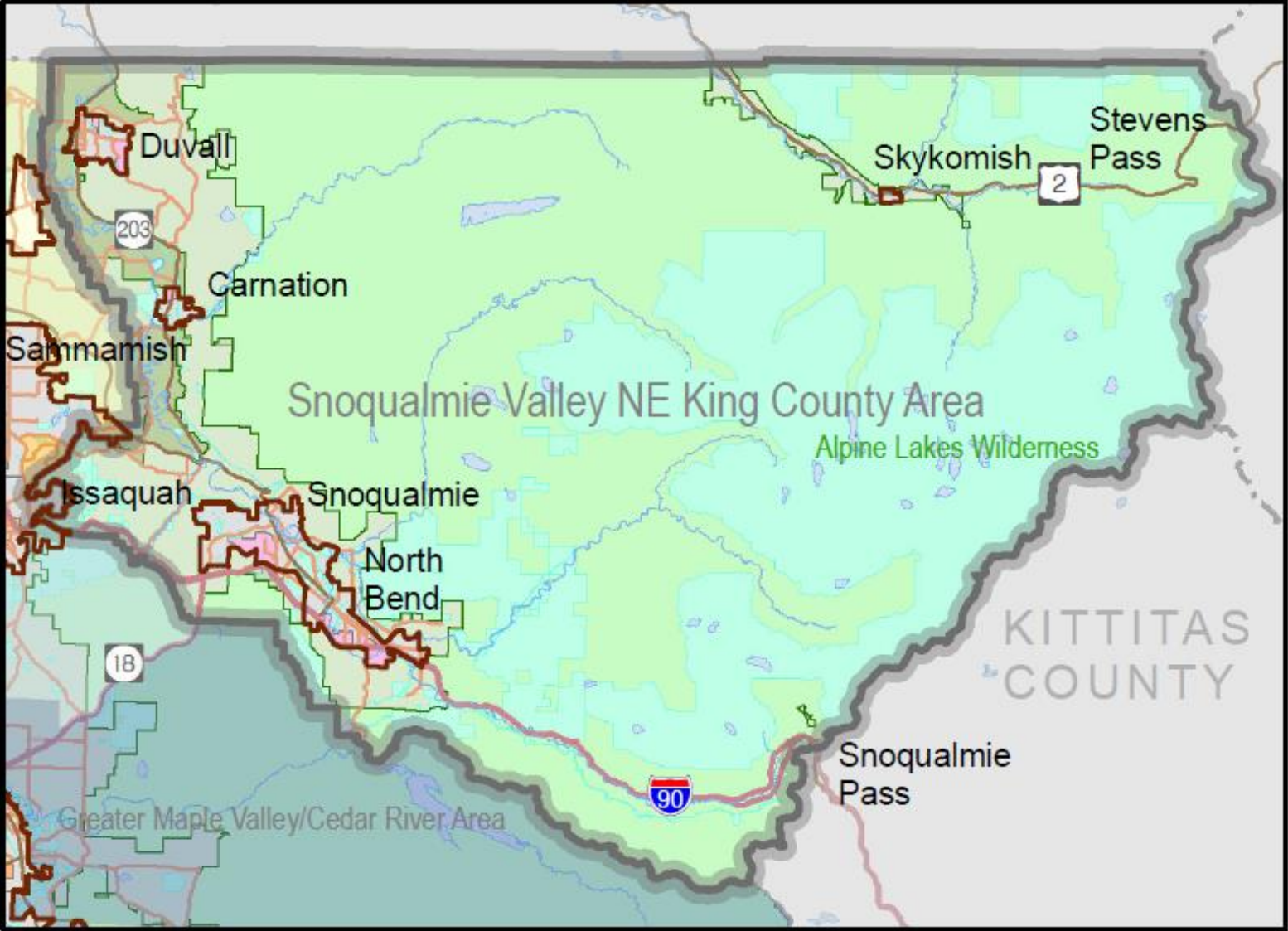

- 20-year, forward-looking document
- Adopts a community vision
- Adopts policies to support the vision

Community Needs List

- List of County projects
- Projects prioritized High/Medium/Low
- Projects support Subarea Plan Vision

Both will be based on and directed by engagement and discussion with the community



Community Needs List Timeline

Q3 2021 – Q2 2022

Engagement and collaboration with community throughout – equity engagement and analysis, review of existing needs, ID additional needs, work with elected officials and community to prioritize needs, evaluate in context of 2023-24 budget.



Q3 2022

Finalize Executive recommended Community Needs List as developed with community, equity engagement and analysis



Q4 2022

Council review, amendment, & adoption



2023 and Beyond

Implementation of adopted Community Needs List

Subarea Plan Timeline

July 2021

Launch subarea planning



Q3 2021 – Q3 2022

Engagement and collaboration with community throughout – equity engagement and analysis, establish scope, vision, guiding principles; develop long-range policies; analyze amendments to land use and zoning; environmental review with formal comment period; public review draft for public review.



Q4 2022

Finalize Executive recommended subarea plan as developed with community



Q1 – Q2 2023

Council review, amendment, & adoption.



Q3 2023 and beyond

Implementation of adopted 20-year subarea plan.
