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STORYMAP PROCESS OVERVIEW

Step 1: Outreach

When: February-April

Who: Subregional Coordinators, Coalitions and AtHW members

How: Distribute the invitation to participate!

Step 2: Initial Contact Interviews (phone or zoom)

- Review: one pager
- Sign: Storymap Project - Informed Consent
- Explain: Process and Content Form
- Arrange in-person story sharing interview

Total time for participant: ~30 minutes



Step 3: Preparation

Participant to **independently** review guiding questions in the Storymap Procedure template

Total time for participant ~30 minutes



Step 4: Story Collection Session – in-person

- flesh out guiding questions from the Storymap Procedure document
- audio recording (for editing/quotes)
- get photo (if they didn't bring/send one)
- arrange follow up phone call for review of draft story

Total time for participant: ~1.5 hours



Step 5: Follow up call to review draft of story:

- Participant receives a draft of story via email ahead of call
- Participant reviews and suggests edits if needed
- Participant approves

Total time for Participant ~30 minutes

Total Participant Commitment:

Initial Contact Interview: ~30 minutes

Review, draft answers to guiding questions: ~30 minutes

In person Story Sharing Session: ~1.5 hours

Final review and approval: ~30 minutes

Total time for Participant ~3 hours

Compensation: \$175.00

(Possible reimbursement for child-care or travel expenses if necessary.)
