

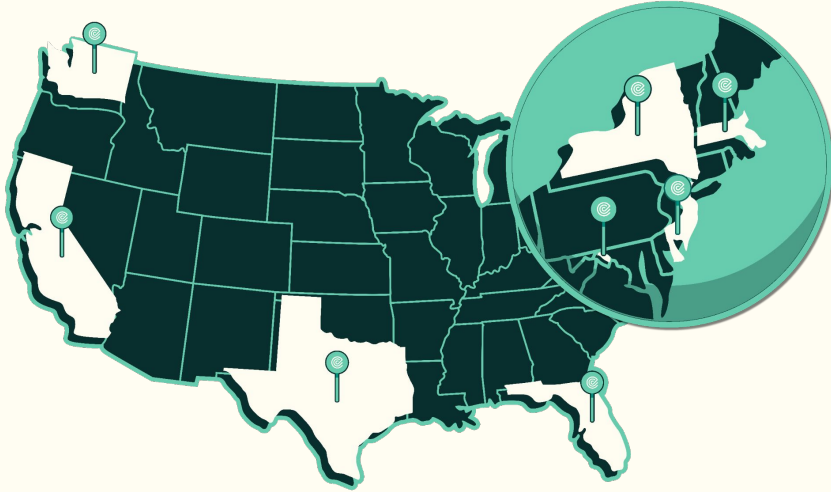

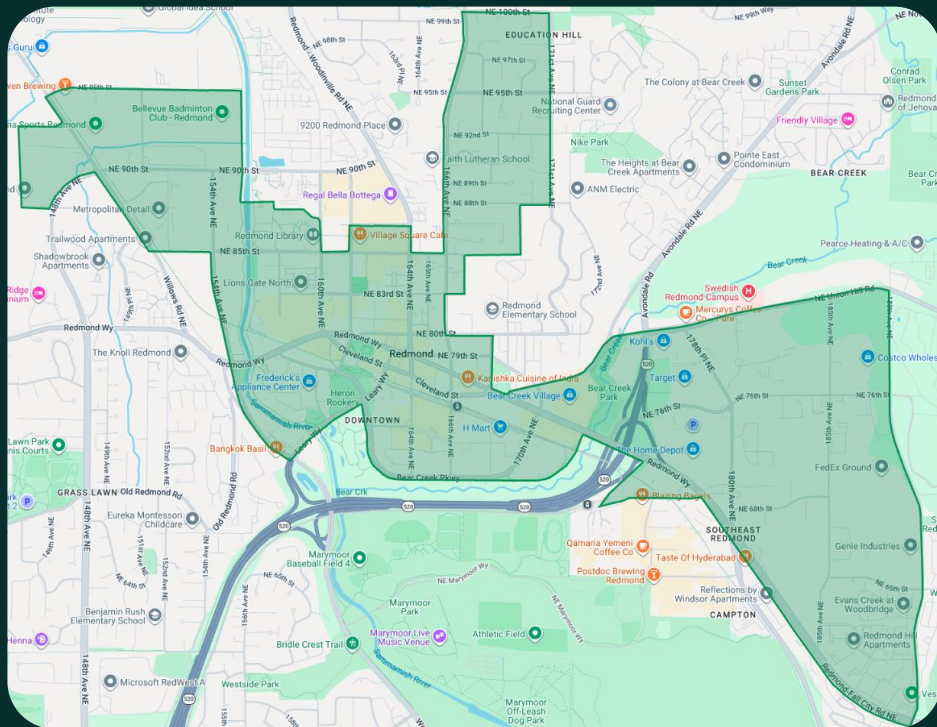

Smart Pooling Algorithm

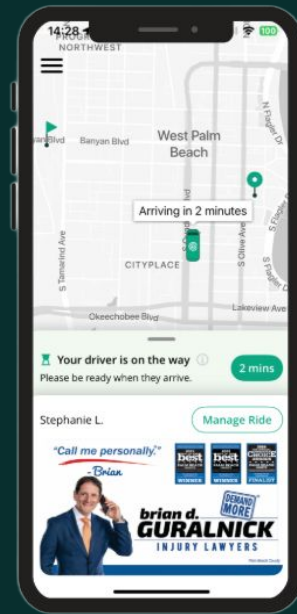
The core of our operational efficiency lies in our proprietary ride pooling engine – riders traveling in the same general direction are matched and grouped into a single vehicle.

Passenger Fare Capabilities

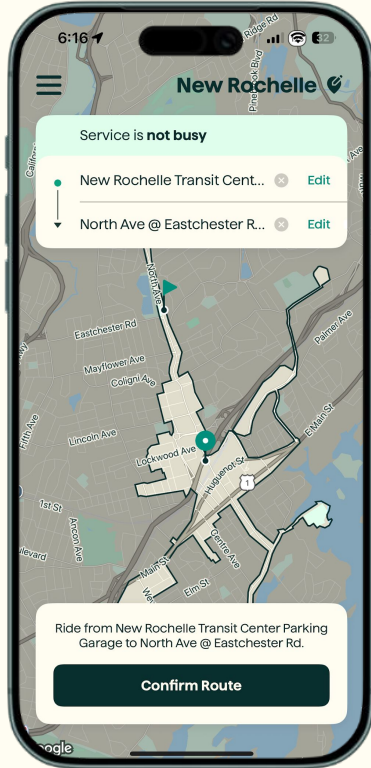
Option to turn on customer-specific discounts (e.g., seniors, disabled riders) or different fares by zone, origin, or destination to balance program objectives.

Local Business Collaboration

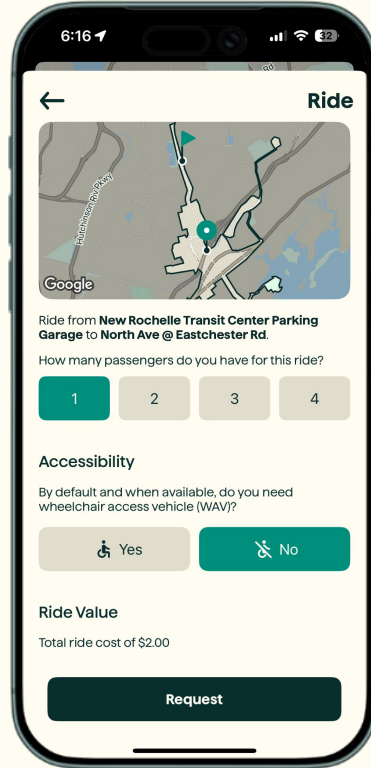

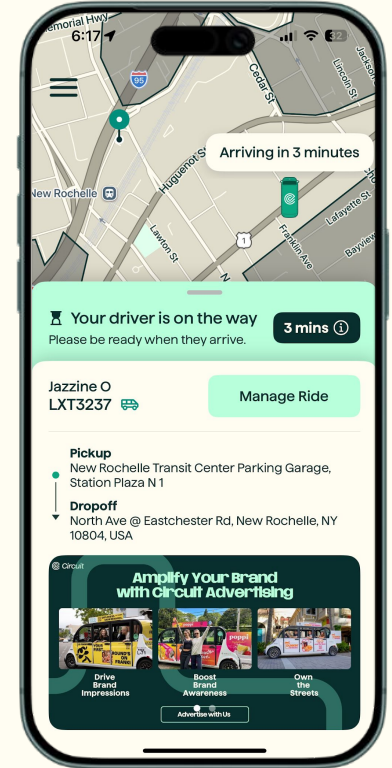

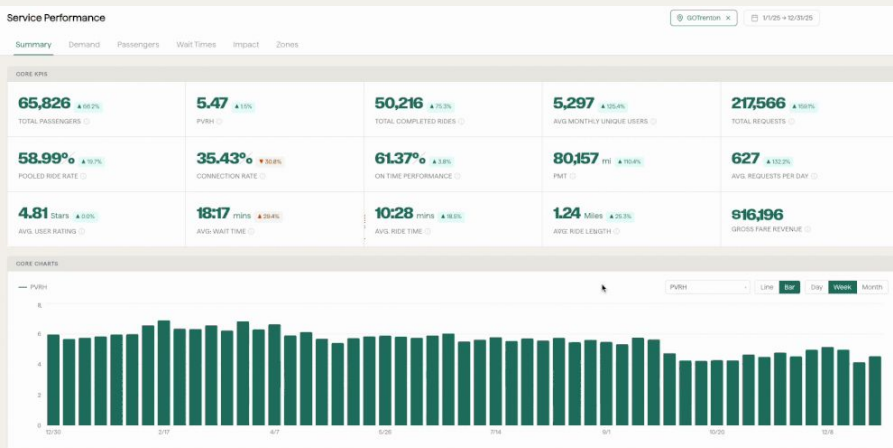

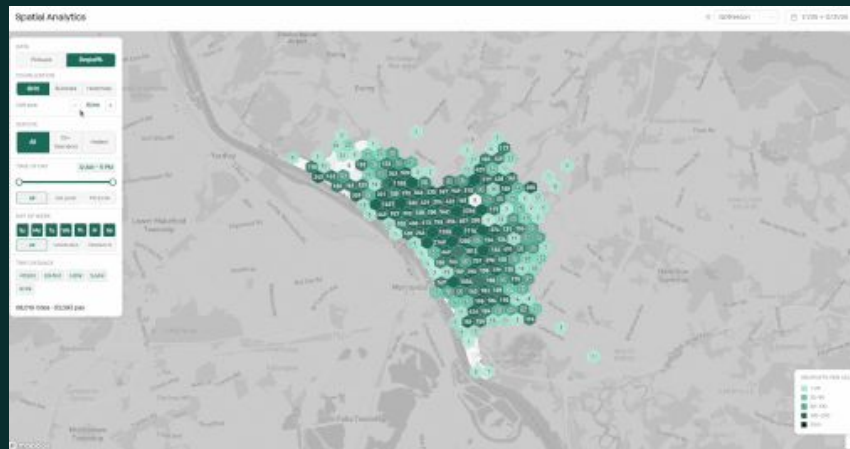
