

North King County Mobility Coalition Fiscal Year 2026 Work Plan

NKCMC Vision & Mission Statement

Vision: A transportation network that allows all people to move freely around North King County and the surrounding region.

Mission Statement: As the regional mobility coalition in North King County, the North King County Mobility Coalition (NKCMC) works to facilitate mobility improvement projects for special needs populations in North King County, improve education and awareness of transportation needs, and coordinates with members and service providers to identify transportation challenges. The NKCMC focuses its efforts on older adults, people with disabilities, low-income households, people experiencing homelessness, refugees, recent immigrants, limited-English proficient (LEP) populations, youth, and other populations that are disproportionately affected by limited transportation options.

NKCMC Fiscal Year 2027 Priorities

Priority 1: Maintain and expand the diversity of NKCMC partnerships to include transportation providers, cities, advocates, human service providers, tribes, and community members.

Priority 2: Highlight transportation barriers and difficulties for particular demographics. Assist in finding potential solutions and continuing advocacy for future wayfinding solutions by exploring new channels to engage with communities.

Priority 3: Strengthen relationships and support projects and planning efforts of coalition partners and other stakeholders. Including, coordinating and supporting outreach efforts.

NKCMC Fiscal Year 2027 Work Plan Projects

Project 1: North King County Mobility Coalition Speaker Series (July 2026 – June 2027).

Identify topics of interest (transportation/mobility related) from coalition partners. Host in person quarterly speaker series throughout the fiscal year based on feedback and ideas from partners. Speaker/topic ideas include external funding opportunities for cities and organizations and sidewalk accessibility and maintenance advocacy.

Project 2: Take Transit with Me Video Series (July 2026 – June 2027).

Begin a transit trip video series accessible through social media and kcmobility.org. Video series will be educational and follow the structure of “can you get from A to B, using X mode of transportation?”. Made for the public, but focusing on amenities such as senior/community

centers, shopping/medical centers, and transit hubs. The series will be like a digital version of a Public Transit Orientation, with the future possibility for people to submit requests for start/end point and mode of transportation.

Project 3: Welcome Packet (July 2026 – June 2027).

Create a North King County Mobility Coalition welcome packet for members of the coalition. Welcome packets will include information on the coalition’s mission and vision and will define projects, partners, and expectations of members.

Fiscal Year 2027 Mobility Education and Outreach Efforts

In support of the NKCMC priorities, vision, and mission, the mobility coordinator also engages in education and outreach efforts across the region. These efforts are incorporated into coalition projects when applicable and exist independently as an effort of the Hopelink Mobility Management team. Coalition members are always welcome to partner in outreach and education efforts. In the 2027 fiscal year, the coordinator will prioritize outreach opportunities that are hosted in partnership with other service providers and offer opportunities for wrap-around connections.

The outreach programming of the coordinator consists of three main programs: Travel Ambassador Trainings, Getting Around Puget Sound events, and Public Transit Orientations. These programs focus on the end-user, the community member, and making accessible the information community members need for getting to where they need to go.
