RARET Vision & Mission Statement

Vision: A coordinated network supporting the Puget Sound region with equitable and resilient transportation services in an emergency.

Mission Statement: Increase the life-sustaining transportation services available to seniors, people with disabilities, low-income individuals, and other vulnerable populations in the event of a major emergency in the Central Puget Sound region.

RARET Fiscal Year 2023 Priorities

- Priority 1** Establish the Emergency Transportation Provider Network (ETPN) by securing formal commitments from at least 10 providers.
- Priority 2** Support the One-Call/One-Click project by collaborating on initiatives, serving as a subject matter expert, and participating in meetings and planning efforts.
- Priority 3** Coordinate responses to emerging needs and participate in regionally relevant emergency preparedness events when they arise.

RARET Fiscal Year 2023 Work Plan Projects

1. Secure WSDOT Consolidated Grant Funding – July through November 2022

Secure 4 more years of funding for RARET's work by applying for and receiving Washington State Department of Transportation's (WSDOT) Consolidated Grant. Obtain at least 20% in-kind match support from local partners for RARET's initiatives.

2. Establish Emergency Transportation Provider Network (ETPN) – July through June

Formally establish the ETPN by finalizing operation plans, securing formal commitments from providers, and testing the network practically and through tabletop exercises. Develop planning documents including memorandums of understanding, a flow chart documenting roles/responsibilities and triggers, a survey tool, and a resource/training wish list.
