


# Overview of Proposal


- King County Metro to restore 80,000 service hours suspended in 2020
- Overall service in South King County to increase by 28%
- Weekend service to increase by 72%
- Weekday service to increase by 51%
- New MetroFlex Zones in Auburn and Federal Way







