



Paul E. Caswell Memorial Fund Scholarship Criteria

- Purpose:** The Paul E. Caswell Memorial Fund awards scholarships to continuing ed-bound high school seniors based on demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and an express interest in pursuing a career in automotive performance and mechanical repair.
- Criteria:** The students eligible for assistance must be graduating high school seniors who reside in Vanderburgh, Warrick, Gibson, Poseyville, Spencer, Henderson, Webster, Union, McLean, or Daviess County and intend to further their education through vocational schooling, an accredited college, or classes and fees needed to attain automotive certifications. Consideration will be given to academic achievement with a minimum 3.0 GPA, financial need, and the students area of interest and future goals in the automotive industry. Students should submit a scholarship application along with a five-minute video or 1000-word essay sharing their background, passion, completed projects, and career pursuit to the email provided.
- Guidelines:** Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed... Proof of acceptance or current student enrollment is required prior to funds being released. Presentation of the scholarships will be held annually at the Full Throttle Cruise-In & Charity Event.
- Amount:** Two scholarships will be awarded annually in the amount of \$2,500.
- Deadline:** **Applications are accepted year round.**
