Suggested Formats

Opens - Singles	Best of 2 tiebreak sets (3 rd set match tiebreak)
Opens - Doubles	Best of 2 tiebreak sets (3 rd set match tiebreak)
Juniors & Club Events (3, 4 or 5 teams)	1 tiebreak set, tiebreak at 5-all
Juniors & Club Events (6 teams)	One short set (First to 5), tiebreak at 4-all
Juniors & Club Events – Play-offs	Best of 2 tiebreak sets (3 rd set match tiebreak)

Tournament Entry Conditions

The Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Regulations as laid down by Tennis NSW/Tennis Australia; except as altered in the program and these conditions.

- There will be a maximum of 15 minutes break between matches.
- Players must report to the tournament desk 15 minutes prior to scheduled match. Forfeits may be given immediately if you fail to sign-in by the scheduled match time.
- Tournament will be conducted on Synthetic Grass. Main Venue: Wests Tennis Club - 16 Old Leumeah Rd, Leumeah NSW
- Draws will be published on the tennismacarthur.com.au website, at least 3 days prior to the event start date
- The Tournament Committee shall have entire control and management of the Tournament
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel any event or combine events according to entries received.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to conduct the tournament under lights
- Match formats may be altered at the discretion of the tournament committee
- Entries close date is specified on the tournament schedule, and late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Committee, and where it benefits the event draw.
- Scheduling requests will not be considered. Players should be available to play all dates set out in the event schedule
- Once matches have been scheduled there will be NO changes.
- Withdrawals must be submitted by email. No refunds will be given for withdrawals received after the entry closing date.
- The Tournament Committee has the right to change player's grades if deemed too strong for the nominated grade entered. Players UTR at the time of making draws, will be used to determine players grading and seedings.
- The Tournament Committee has the right to reject a player's entry without reason.
- I give Tennis Macarthur permission to take photographic images of me and use images taken of me in publications and promotional material, broadcast, print and electronic media.

Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in the Tennis Macarthur Club Championships, players must be a member of Tennis Macarthur and,

- live within the Macarthur or Liverpool region or,
- be a registered player in one senior Tennis Macarthur competition commencing after 1 September 2024,
- be a registered full term player in the current term 4 Junior Competition,
- be a registered full term player in two junior competitions, either Term 4 2023, Term 1 2024, or Term 2 2024.
