Format

Juniors & Opens

- Teams will consist of 3 players.
- Where possible there will be 4 team divisions so that a full 6 rounds can be played

Division 1, 2 & Open

- Play 3 set format & 2 sets of doubles.
- Under 10's and all other division play 1 set of singles and 2 sets of doubles

Seniors

- Teams will consist of 4 players.
- Over 60's considered if enough entries are received.

Eligibility

1. Players must be a current Tennis Macarthur member.
2. Players must live within the boundaries of Tennis Macarthur **OR** be a registered member of a team in a competition run by Tennis Macarthur in the previous 12 months **OR** have played in the 2025 Tennis Macarthur Championships.
3. A special guest approved by the Tennis Macarthur Committee.

Team Selections

Selections Will Be Based On:

- Previous performances & reliability in Inter District & commitment to Tennis Macarthur competitions &/or events.
- Competition grading & results.
- UTR rating.
- Trials (if required). Some players will be required to attend a trial, you will be notified by email if you need to attend.
- Players must know the game's rules and be able to play in self-umpired matches.
- Behaviour and attitude.
- Open & Senior Teams - may submit names for a team to be considered.
- Each team will have a Manager. The Manager will be selected from one of the parents in each team.
 - Responsibilities of the Manager will include but are not limited to - finding out where the team is playing each week and ensuring all team members are notified, assist in sourcing a reserve player where required (a list of reserves will be provided).

Team Announcements:

- You will be advised if you are selected via email.
- Teams will be published on the Tennis Macarthur website.

Uniform

- All players for Tennis Macarthur are to wear the white Tennis Macarthur shirt and your own Navy shorts/skirt.
- Shirts are \$25 (a discounted price for Inter District players).
- Order your shirt on the nomination form.

Terms & Conditions Of Entry
