



THE PORCH POOL RULES

- Use of these facilities is at the user's own risk. No lifeguard is on duty.
- MAX BATHER load is 247.
- The pools are open from May to October during published hours. Entry into the pool area at any other time is strictly prohibited.
- Users must be a resident/member of Oakmont in good standing.
- All guests must be accompanied by a RESIDENT/MEMBER 18 years or older.
- Residents under the age of 14 years must be accompanied by an adult resident who is responsible for fully supervising the minor and remaining with them in the same pool area.
- Running, jumping, general horseplay, throwing objects to one another in or out of the water which might strike someone and cause injury or nuisance, or any other disorderly conduct is not permitted.
- Changing diapers within 6 feet of the pool is prohibited. Diapers should be changed in restrooms located inside The Porch.
- Do not swim if you have been ill with diarrhea within the past 2 weeks.
- GLASS containers are not allowed in the pool area.
- ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are not allowed in the pool area.
- NO SMOKING or VAPING is allowed inside or outside The Porch.
- NO PETS are permitted in the pool area
- Instructions from pool manager or association staff members must be followed, whether or not the rule has been published.
- Appropriate attire designated for swimming, with an attached inn lining, is required of all swimmers. T-shirts and thongs are not permitted.
- Diving, somersaults, back dives, cannonballs, can openers, or other similar type entries from the edge of the pool is not permitted.
- Extended breath holding activities are dangerous and prohibited.
- Please deposit all trash in the trash cans provided.
- Failure to follow rules may result in immediate removal from the pool area.
