

Boulders Roll to Matinee Win Score Five Runs Before Making an Out

UNDATED — The Boulders avenged their first road loss of the season with a 12-8 series tying victory over the Ottawa Titans (7-4) on Wednesday afternoon at Ottawa Stadium.

New York (8-3) sent 10 men to the plate and erupted for six runs in the first inning, scoring five times before the home team could record an out. LF **John Schroeder**'s two-run double followed RBI singles from RF **Aaron Simmons**, 1B **Jason Agresti**, and 2B **Santino Rosso**.

Simmons, Agresti, and DH **Dan Tauken** also picked up an RBI apiece in the Boulders' four-run top of the fifth, after which the score was 10-1.

RHP **Emmett Bice** (W, 1-0 / 6 IP, 2 R, 2 H, 6 BB, 4 K) cruised to his first win of the year, taking a no-hitter into the bottom of the fourth.

The teams play a rubber game tomorrow (Thursday), with another 11am EDT start, as the Boulders look to win their fourth consecutive series.

* C **Jack Scanlon** (4-for-5) recorded the Boulders' second four-hit game of 2026
