

Boulders Drop Rubber Game

Lose Home Series for First Time in '26

Pomona, NY — The Boulders were beaten by the New Jersey Jackals 7-3 in their series finale Thursday night at Clover Stadium.

New Jersey (9-6) took two of three after beating New York (10-6) only once in 12 meetings last year.

The Boulders fell behind 1-0 in the first inning and trailed 5-0 after three. They scratched out single runs in the sixth, seventh, and eighth, getting RBIs from SS **Fritz Genthner** and RF **Dan Tauken**, while 3B **Norris McClure** scored on a wild pitch.

But the Jackals put the game on ice when LF Luis Encarnacion cracked his second 2-run homer of the night in the top of the ninth for the final margin.

Encarnacion and 3B Felix Stevens combined for three home runs and all seven New Jersey RBIs.

The teams hook up at Hinchliffe Stadium in Paterson, New Jersey, for a four-game series starting tomorrow (Friday) night. First pitch is scheduled for 6:35pm EDT.

Also of note:

* Rosso (1-for-4) extended his hitting streak to 12 games (22-49/.449) with a 7th inning double

* Tauken became the first Boulder in 2026 to rack up 20 RBIs

* OF **Julian Boyd** (6th inning triple) collected his first extra-base hit of the season after missing 12 games with an injury
