

Boulders Fall Again in NJ **Drop Fourth in Five Games**

UNDATED — The Boulders rallied from 5-0 down Sunday afternoon at Hinchliffe Stadium in Paterson, NJ, but lost to the Jackals, 8-5.

New York (11-8) fell behind early for the sixth straight game as New Jersey (11-7) put up five runs in the second inning against RHP **Connor Godwin** (ND / 3.2 IP, 5 R, 2 H, 8 BB, 6 K), highlighted by CF Aldalay Kolokie's grand slam.

The Boulders began their comeback with three runs in the top of the fourth, featuring RBI singles for CF **Julian Boyd** and 2B **Kyle Hess**, then tied the score with two runs in the seventh behind RBIs from 1B **Jason Agresti** and 3B **Santino Rosso**.

The deadlock was short lived, as the Jackals struck for three runs in the bottom of the seventh off of LHP **Ethan Bradford** (L, 1-1).

The red, white, and blue brought the tying run up to bat five times over the final two frames, but left two on in the eighth inning and two more in the ninth.

The Boulders will try to gain a split of the four-game wraparound series tomorrow (Monday) morning, with first pitch scheduled for 10:35am EDT.

Also of note:

* Rosso (1-for-5, run, RBI) extended his hitting streak to 15 games (27-63 / .429) with a fourth inning leadoff double

* RHP **Anthony Leak** worked 2.1 hitless and scoreless innings, his 3rd straight such outing this week (6.1 total IP)
