

## **Boulders Lose Series Finale in NJ** Drop Fifth of Seven vs. Jackals

**UNDATED** — The Boulders were held hitless until one out in the sixth inning and fell to the Jackals 5-1 on Monday afternoon in Paterson, New Jersey; their third loss in the four-game series at Hinchliffe Stadium.

New York (11-9) fell behind for the seventh straight game, as New Jersey (12-7) scored a run in the first, two in the second, and one more in the third.

The Boulders only managed five hits on the day – highlighted by two singles from 1B **Norris McClure** – while C **Jack Scanlon** had a single and a ninth inning RBI double.

LHP **Wesley Culley** (L, 0-1 / 4 IP, 4 R, 8 H, 8 K, 2 BB) took the loss in what was an otherwise impressive professional debut, matching LHP **Isaac Rohde's** team season high for strikeouts in a game on the same day he was added to the active roster.

The Boulders will try to get back in the win column tomorrow (Tuesday) night when they open a three-game series in Ottawa against the Titans. First pitch is scheduled for 6:30pm EDT.

Also of note:

\* 2B **Kyle Hess** has a hit in all four games (5-for-17) since returning from IR

\* RHP **Scott Harper**, LHP **Grady Gorgen**, and LHP **Cobe Reeves** combined for four innings of one-run relief with no walks and five strikeouts

\* 3B **Santino Rosso** (0-for-3, walk) saw his 15-game hitting streak come to an end
