

Boulders Roll in Ottawa Rohde Goes Distance in Series Opener

UNDATED — Boulders LHP **Isaac Rohde** threw the team's first complete game of the season and picked up his first win of 2026 in a series opening 6-1 victory at Ottawa Stadium on Tuesday night vs. the Titans (11-10), who suffered their fourth straight loss.

New York (12-9) gave their starting pitcher all the offensive support he'd need in the first two innings, going up 4-0 on the strength of RBI singles from RF **Aaron Simmons** and 1B **Jason Agresti**, along with a run-scoring wild pitch, and an errant throw on a steal of third base.

The only blemish against Rohde (W, 1-1 / 9 IP, 1 R, 5 H, 1 BB, 6 K) was a second inning solo homer by Titans CF Jackson Lyon.

Agresti added an RBI double for the visitors in the top of the fourth, then scored the final run of the night on a seventh inning wild pitch.

The Boulders look to make it two straight W's north of the border tomorrow (Wednesday) night, with first pitch again scheduled for 6:30pm EDT.

* Simmons & Agresti both went 3-for-5, tying their season highs in base hits

* CF **Julian Boyd** scored a season high two runs
