

Boulders Roll Again in Ottawa Get 2nd Straight Dominant Start

UNDATED — Boulders RHP **Emmett Bice** had a tough act to follow after LHP **Isaac Rohde's** complete game in the series opener, but Bice took a shutout into the eighth inning Wednesday night as New York made it 2-for-2 this week in Ottawa, rolling over the Titans 9-1.

The Boulders (13-9) erupted for a six-run top of the third, highlighted by RF **Aaron Simmons'** two-run double and a three-run double from 3B **Santino Rosso**.

The visitors added a run in the fourth and two in the ninth, more than enough for Bice (W, 2-0 / 7.2 IP, 1 R, 6 H, 1 BB, 3 K), who pitched a season high 7 2/3 innings before LHP **Grady Gorgen** and RHP **Tyler Vail** combined to record the final four outs.

The Titans (11-11) suffered their fifth straight loss, scoring their only run on an eighth inning sacrifice fly.

The Boulders have clinched their first road series win of 2026 and can complete a three-game sweep at Ottawa Stadium for the first time since August 27-29, 2024, with a win tomorrow (Thursday) morning. First pitch is scheduled for 11:00am EDT.

Also of note:

* The Boulders got hits from 8 different players, while getting RBI's and runs from 6 different batters

* The last time the Boulders gave up 1 run or fewer in back-to-back road games was during that August 2024 sweep of the Titans (3-1, 2-0, and 2-0)
