

## **Boulders Drop Ottawa Finale** Settle for Two of Three in Series

**UNDATED** — The Boulders were held to just three hits Thursday afternoon at Ottawa Stadium, where they lost 8-3 to the Titans in the last of a seven-game road trip.

New York (13-10) jumped on top in the third inning on a three-run homer by DH **Jason Agresti**, but the lead was gone by the end of the fourth, when Ottawa (12-11) put up a four-spot highlighted by SS Thomas Ferroggiaro's go-ahead three-run shot.

LHP **Garrett Peters** (L, 0-2 / 5 IP, 5 R, 6 H, 2 BB, 4 K) gave up five runs over five innings for the second straight start and took his second loss in a row after beginning his Boulders career with back-to-back no decisions.

The Boulders return to Clover Stadium for a six-game home stand starting tomorrow (Friday) night when they play the first of three against the Down East Bird Dawgs. First pitch is scheduled for 7:00pm EDT.

Also of note:

\* The Boulders wrapped up their first extended road trip of 2026 with a record of 3-4

\* CF **Julian Boyd** had at least one hit (4-for-11 / .364) and one run scored (5) in every game of the series; he's hit safely in six of eight games since coming off IR
