

Boulders Blow Another Early Lead Québec Steals Series Opener in Sudden Death

Pomona, NY — The Boulders lost 6-5 in Sudden Death against the four-time defending Frontier League champion Québec Capitales on Tuesday afternoon at Clover Stadium after coughing up a 5-0 lead.

New York (15-12) built its advantage through the first four innings; C **Jimmy Costin's** return to Rockland County started in style with a two-run double in the second, while LF **John Schroeder** added a two-run homer in the third, and RF **Aaron Simmons** had an RBI single in the fourth.

LHP **Isaac Rohde** (ND / 6.1 IP, 2 R, 4 H, 2 BB, 4 K) left the game with two men on – and both came around to score as the Capitales (21-6) erupted for four runs in the seventh inning, then tied things up at 5-5 in the top of the ninth.

After a scoreless tenth, the visitors walked off with a Sudden Death win on DH David Mendham's RBI single.

The Boulders – who led 7-0 Sunday vs. Down East – look to even the series tomorrow (Wednesday) morning, with first pitch again scheduled for 10:30am EDT on the final "School Day" game of the season

Also of note:

* 2B **Kyle Hess** (first inning HBP) reached base for the 11th straight game since coming off IR

* Simmons is 8-for-16 (.500) during a 4-game hitting streak

* Costin began his second tour with the Boulders (also 2023-24) after starting the season with the Missoula Paddleheads of the Pioneer League
